

FROM FR. STEVE....

Hi everybody, please welcome Fr. Joseph Westfall to Saint Mary Magdalene Parish! Fr. Westfall will speak at all the Masses on behalf of Cross Catholic Outreach. We have had priests from Cross Catholic Outreach visiting us in the past. You might recall that Cross Catholic Outreach was founded to forge a stronger and more supportive link between parishes in America and the priest and the nuns serving the poor in the Caribbean, Africa, Southeast Asia and Central and South America. Fr. Westfall was ordained in the Diocese of Lafavette, Indiana in 1993. While in the seminary, he was moved while serving in an adopted parish in Haiti. In Haiti, he also served at an outreach center ran by his home diocese in Port Au Prince. This experience moved his heart in service to the poor. Later, he focused on healthcare chaplaincy in 1997. Since then, Fr. Joseph has been a board-certified chaplain with the Association of **Professional Chaplains, as well as the National Conference** of Veterans Affairs Catholic Chaplains. He has been a Chaplain with the Department of Veteran Affairs for 15 years. He is currently the Chief of Chaplain Services for the VA in Hudson Valley in New York. Speaking of outreach, The El Salvador-Latin America Collection is on the weekend of January 25th & 26th. This appeal is for the two priests who work in parishes served by our Missionaries. 
LUNCH PACKING January 27th

SACRAMENTS Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. If you are interested please contact the Parish Office. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith should contact the parish office ~ 440-943-2133.

First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Fr. Steve Breck at 440-943-2133.

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. Marriage

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
