



#### FROM FR. STEVE....

The proceeds from the MegaRaffle help with our Winter Operational Expenses. Also, Happy February everyone! This Weekend we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord. Would you believe February 2nd is forty days after Christmas? Time is flying by. Today we celebrate a joyful moment told in the second chapter of Saint Luke's Gospel. When Jesus was forty days old, Mary and Joseph brought him to the Temple in Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. In this story we hear about Anna and Simeon, these two elderly people of great holiness recognized Him. In the story, Simeon spoke a beautiful prayer that is repeated by many every night from the Liturgy of the Hours. Those that pray Night Prayer from the Liturgy of the Hours will pray the Canticle of Simeon before the Glory Be, the closing prayer and a hymn to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Canticle of Simeon goes like this, "Lord, now you let your servant go in peace; your word has been fulfilled: my own eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared in the sight of every people: a light to reveal you to the nations and the glory of your people Israel." Simeon called Jesus, "a light to the nations." On today's celebration, candles are blessed. That's why today is also called, "Candlemas." Hopefully, this feast calls to mind the receiving of the baptismal candle at baptism. May we faithfully carry the light of Christ everywhere we go! Plus, we will be blessing throats this weekend. The blessing of throats is associated with the Feast of Saint Blaise. The Feast of Saint Blaise is February 3<sup>rd</sup>. Thank you Bette Ingraham for sprucing up the ribbon on the throat blessing candle. At the end of the Universal Prayer, a.k.a. The Prayer of the Faithful, instead of the closing prayer, I will do a general blessing of throats. I will be offering individual blessing of throats after Mass. February 2<sup>nd</sup> is also the halfway point between the winter solstice and spring equinox. Many refer to this day as Ground Hog's Day where Punxsutawney Phil makes his appearance. Hopefully the blessing will keep you healthy as we finish the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of winter. This weekend we celebrate World Day For Consecrated Life. We recognize and give thanks for those who have consecrated their lives to God and the Church through the vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. The consecrated life is one way that women and men live out their baptismal commitment as followers of Jesus. Please pray for all those who have made commitments in the consecrated life. 




## SNOW ALERTS!!!

### **Baptism**

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith should contact the parish office ~ 440-943-2133.

#### **First Communion**

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Fr. Steve Breck at 440-943-2133.

#### **Confirmation**

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

## **Anointing of the Sick**

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.




