The Harriet Tubman Movement is an advocacy group that serves people who have been subjected to sex trafficking, prostitution or other forms of exploitation. Did you know many children are forced into labor in the cocoa fields? The number is staggering that assists in the harvesting of cocoa beans. The International Labour Office estimates that there are approximately 25 million men, women, and children subjected to labor or sex trafficking worldwide. 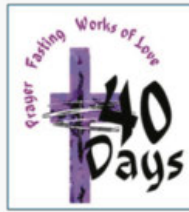

### Baptism
