

Happy Fourth Sunday of Lent Everybody! This weekend, the Fourth Sunday of Lent is known as *Laetare* Sunday and is a day of joy. This is the halfway mark of Lent, and Holy Week is near! The color for this week is rose and the priest at Mass has the option to wear rose colored vestments. Speaking of Holy Week, Monday, March 31st is the Dr. Brant Pitre's Jewish Roots of Holy Week Part One presented by Mike Weikart. This presentation will be in the Kaminski Center. The first session is at 3:30PM and the encore presentation is at 5:30PM. You only need to attend one of the sessions. This Tuesday, April 1st, no foolin', is our Communal Cluster Penance Service from 6PM to 7:30PM. There will be five confessors available this evening. Stop at Saint Mary Magdalene Church between 6PM and 7:30PM for Adoration and the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. April 5th is Jesus Day for our 2nd graders preparing for Holy Communion. Thank you, parents for trusting us to help prepare your children and God bless our 2ndgraders preparing to receive their 1st Holy Communion. Deacon Brian Peters will be with us offering a reflection on Sunday, April 6th at 2PM in the Church at our Special Lenten Holy Hour. Welcome back, Deacon Brian! Then on Monday, April 7th, we will begin working on a section of pews. So, 9AM Mass will be in Room 104 for the week. In the event of a funeral, we will have it at Saint Justin Martyr Parish. Sorry for the inconvenience. Our Tuesday Holy Hour at 3PM will also be in Room 104. Do you have a will? Did you know 68% of Americans do not have a will? 
The Jewish Roots of Holy Week

SACRAMENTS

Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. If you are interested please contact the Parish Office. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith should contact the parish office ~ 440-943-2133.

First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Fr. Steve Breck at 440-943-2133.

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. Marriage

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
