After Mass I will then be saying goodbye to the Whacky Shack for the Summer with a ride or two at Waldameer Amusement Park. Speaking of goodbye, we say goodbye to Fr. Kevin Klonowski. Fr. Kevin will be back for his summer break beginning in July. We are all grateful to have Fr. Kevin with us! He is a very kind and prayerful priest. Plus, he is good company. Fr. Kevin is deeply grateful for your hospitality, friendship and prayers. God bless Fr. Kevin! Our KofC will be selling tickets for their Pasta Dinner after Mass. The dinner is Sunday, September 14th from Noon to 2:30PM. Tickets are also on sale in the parish office during normal business hours. September 14th is the first day of class for our PSR students. 



Baptism

Confirmation

Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.
