## FROM FR. STEVE...

Happy Holy Week Everyone! We begin Holy Week with our Palm Sunday Masses. In the evening, our eight Confirmation Candidates will be doing their Service Project in the Multi-Purpose Room at 5PM. On Holy Monday we have 9AM Mass and Confessions from 5:30PM to 6:15PM. Holy Tuesday is the Chrism Mass at Saint Sebastian Parish in West Akron. There is no 3PM Lenten Holy Hour on the 31<sup>st</sup> but there is 9AM Mass. Spy Wednesday we have 9AM Mass and Confessions from Noon to 1PM. On Holy Thursday we have 9AM Morning Prayer and the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7PM. Even though Spy Wednesday was the day before, I need you to do some "spying" at the Holy Thursday Mass. Bob and I are wondering if it is time to do something different for the washing of the feet. We will still have this important part of the celebration, but the number of participants getting their feet washed has dwindled in recent years. So, we are wondering if we need to adjust the way we celebrate the washing of feet. So, if you are attending the Mass here on Holy Thursday, "watch and pray" to see if we should keep it as it is or do something different. On Good Friday we have Morning Prayer at 9AM, Stations of the Cross at Noon, Good Friday Service at 3PM and Divine Mercy Novena at 5:30PM in the Chapel. Thank you Tony and Danny Linc for leading the Novena and supplying the booklets and Divine Mercy Image. The Novena is every night from Good Friday to Saturday, April 11<sup>th</sup> at 5:30PM. Then our Divine Mercy Sunday Service is on April 12<sup>th</sup> at 12:30PM. You may recall on April 30, 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized the Polish nun who had received from Christ the amazing revelations of the Divine Mercy in the early years of the twentieth century, Saint Mary Faustina Kowalska. During that ceremony, the pope fulfilled one of the requests that Christ had made through those revelations: that the entire Church reserve the Second Sunday of the Easter Season to honor and commemorate God's infinite mercy. The celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday is an opportunity to reflect on the theme of how God's mercy can overcome sin and God's tremendous love for us. Now back to Holy week! On Holy Saturday, we have 9AM Morning Prayer, 3PM Food Blessing and the Easter Vigil at 9PM. At the Easter Vigil, we have Christopher Williams, Laurie Petrich, Emma Mangan, Vivian Studniarz receiving the Sacraments of Initiation. Ray Hyclak will make his Profession of Faith and will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion. Vivian's brother Tommy will be Confirmed and make his 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion. Susan Simmons Granddaughter Ryan Lovick will make her 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion at the Mass too! Easter Sunday Masses are 8AM, 9:30AM with Fr. Eric Garris as the celebrant and 11AM with Fr. Rich Evans as the celebrant. God bless!

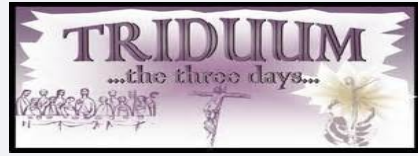

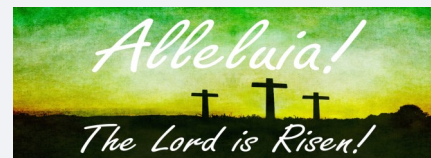

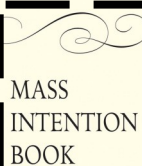

## DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The First Sunday After Easter

### THE PROMISE

Our Lord Jesus said, "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates throughout which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy."

— Saint Faustina, Diary, 699

### WHY IS THIS PROMISE FROM JESUS SO WONDERFUL AND MERCIFUL?

**TEMPORAL PUNISHMENT AND SUFFERING:** The Catholic Church teaches that sin has two consequences, or punishments. (CCC 1472). The first is eternal punishment in which the soul loses Heaven and is confined to an eternity in Hell. This punishment is remitted through the forgiveness of sins. The second is temporal punishment, in which a person must expiate, or make reparation for his sins. This temporal punishment remains even after sin is forgiven. This temporal punishment is known as Purgatory.

So, Jesus's amazing promise to St. Faustina amounts to offering all mankind the graces of a COMPLETE PARDON: an opportunity to have all temporal punishment, time in Purgatory, that which would be necessary before entrance into Heaven, completely removed!

### THE DIVINE MERCY FEAST DAY

"I desire that there be a feast of mercy. I want this image, which you will paint with a brush to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be known as the Feast of Mercy."

## So, What's Happening in the Gathering Area?

This year the concept for the Lenten design in our Gathering Area was introduced by Bob Soeder.

He approached the Art and Environment Committee about an idea he had to merge our design with the Lenten prelude song, "Wood of the Cradle." We said absolutely!

Wood of the Cradle, Wood of the Cross



The cross we decided to use was designed by one of our Cantors, Jude Shellito. Last year, Jude was commissioned by the Diocese of Cleveland to design and create 12 crosses, which then were distributed at various locations throughout our Diocese for The Year of Hope. During the year people were encouraged to make a "pilgrimage" to one those parishes and by doing so would receive a plenary indulgence. Now we have one of the hand-crafted crosses. Jude also agreed to build a Cradle so we would have the connection to our prelude song.

The design itself is an extension of the design in the church which sets a calm, meditative environment of prayer and reflection with the Cross and Cradle as the centerpiece.

The basic design will remain for the Easter Season merging our whole story together. The birth of Jesus in a cradle. His death on the cross. And his glorious resurrection! Touches of white draping will break up the rough burlap. Flowers will fill the space with new life and The Crown of Thorns will become a Crown of Flowers. All a celebration of new life and new beginnings!

### Baptism

### Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. 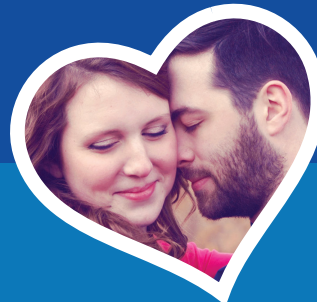
