Happy Holy Trinity Sunday Everybody! The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* teaches that “the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in Himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the ‘hierarchy of the truths of faith.’ (paragraph 234). Also, Happy Parish Festival Weekend Everyone! Thank you for supporting our parish festival by volunteering or bringing your family and friends to have a great time. Your support is sincerely appreciated. Also, thank you, festival team for planning such a great event! Remember, we have free shuttle service. Park at Dudley Park, get a ride on the bus and get dropped off at the entrance. This free shuttle service eliminates the hassle of finding a parking spot and a wonderful convenience if you have limited mobility. Next weekend is Corpus Christi, The Most Holy Body And Blood Of Christ. At the end of the 11AM Mass we will have a Eucharistic Procession and conclude with Benediction. If you are not staying for the procession, please be careful when exiting the parking lot. If you join the procession, thank you and please remember this is a solemn occasion so please refrain from any unnecessary small talk while in procession. After Benediction, our KofC will be offering a “grab & go” lunch of hot dogs, pop and chips. Thank you KofC! Please know you can grab, eat and gab if you like. Also, next weekend is the Catholic Charities 2026 Follow-Up In Pew Appeal Weekend. This is another opportunity to support Catholic Charities here in our diocese in case you missed the In Pew Appeal in February. All donations to this second appeal will directly help those struggling to meet their most basic needs. In 2025 Catholic Charities was able to provide hot meals to 610 people every day. It supported 2,000 families by providing access to groceries through their food pantries. 362 families were able to stay together and avoid being unhoused because of the financial support for evictions and utility shut-off prevention provided Catholic Charities Emergency Services Department. Catholic Charities Emergency Services is a service that is needed in all eight counties of the Diocese. Your gift will keep these services going and help those in need. Thank you for your support. Daily Mass on Wednesday June 10th will be in Room 103. The Ceiling above the sanctuary is being painted blue to match the Choir Loft Wall and the Holy Family Wall. Daily Mass will resume in the Church on June 12th. Sorry for the inconvenience. 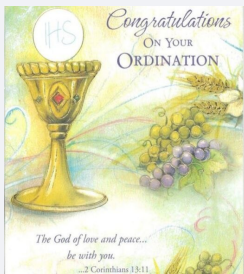

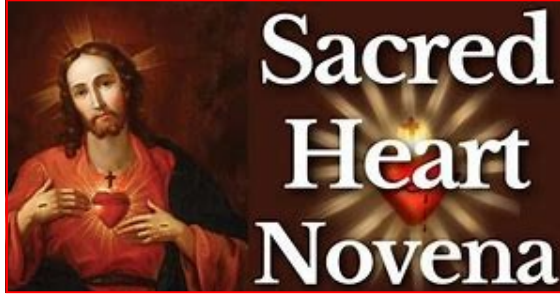

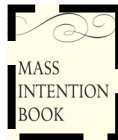

Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. If you are interested please contact the Parish Office. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith should contact the parish office ~ 440-943-2133.

First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Fr. Steve Breck at 440-943-2133.

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. Marriage

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.

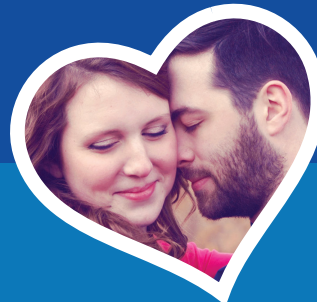
