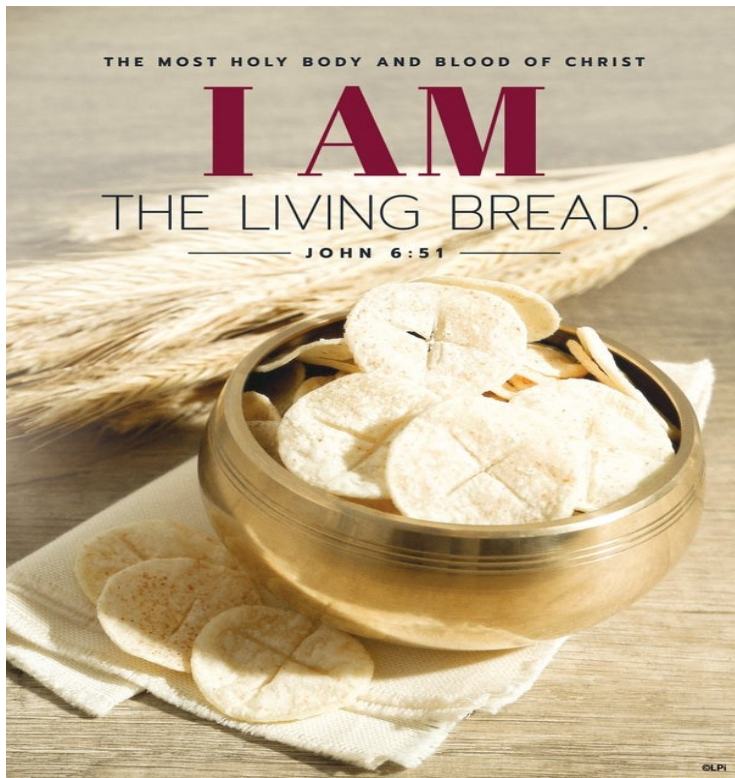
## Parish Mission Statement

## *FROM FR. STEVE...*

Happy June everybody! This weekend we celebrate Corpus Christi where we solemnly commemorate the institution of the Eucharist. May we always have a deep love for this precious gift of the Lord's Real Presence and receive the Eucharist often. May we never stray from such a precious gift and always be properly disposed! Plus, it is also my prayer that we always celebrate well. Thank you for your active participation. You sing and respond well! Also, you are very hospitable. Keep up the good work! Please keep in mind, when some folks have a need for quiet conversation with our Lord, they look forward to their Church for an opportunity. Some look forward to some silent contemplation and prayer with our Lord before or after Mass. So please be mindful of any conversation you have before or after Mass. Someone near you might be praying a rosary or engaged in mental prayer. I must say I am glad no one brings coffee or other types of beverages to Mass. I understand some may need water due to medications. I need some water due to allergies. I do take an antihistamine but sometimes my throat gets dry and I can't speak. Some thought I was Fr. Peter Brady at our recent Confirmation Mass! With that, please remember when we have a social in the gathering area, no food or drink in the Church. And keep up the good work of not chewing gum during Mass. I rarely see that happening. Typically, we do a good job, but I noticed cell phones have been ringing at Mass. I always try leave mine in the sacristy or at the rectory. So please be sure to check that your phone is set to vibrate mode or hide it in your car. I don't see this often, but I've noticed occasionally a male wearing a hat in Church. Maybe they do not realize they have them on. Now Ladies can wear hats or veils in Church. Luckily, we do not have many consecrated hosts fall to the floor during Communion. I am glad we are careful distributing and receiving Holy Communion. When receiving in the hand, I think it is best to lay your hand flat, one on top of the other, and consume the consecrated host immediately. If you receive on the tongue, it is okay to stick your tongue out at me. Also, good job responding, "Amen" and bowing before receiving. I hope you do not mind I took this opportunity to go over a few "housekeeping items." I think none of us want to say or do anything that would distract people's attention from the Mass. At the end of the 11AM Mass we will have a Eucharistic Procession. If you are not staying for the procession, please be careful when exiting the parking lot. Thank You KofC for the hot dogs, chips and pop for the "grab, gab & go" lunch. God bless and have a great week!

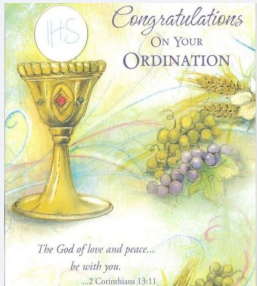

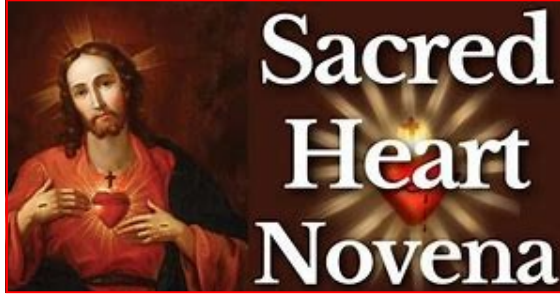

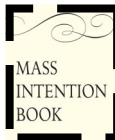

### *From the Catholic Commission....*

June is Gun Violence Awareness Month. Sadly, gun violence homicide and suicide - is the leading cause of death among children (NIH), and more than 44,000 people die each year in America from gun violence (Pew). We must be motivated to act. Catholic Social Teaching (CST) recognizes the relationship between rights and responsibilities, and the USCCB has consistently advocated for policies that respect individual rights but prioritize the common good (A Mercy and Peacebuilding Approach to Gun Violence). What can we in the pews do? One innovative idea is Guns to Gardens where unwanted firearms are beautifully converted into garden tools – “swords into plowshares”. A local gun surrender event is happening on June 20th at Church of the Epiphany in Euclid (216-731-1316) from 11-1pm. We echo Pope Leo, “the voice of weapons must be silenced.”

## SACRAMENTS

### Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. ### First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Fr. Steve Breck at 440-943-2133.

### Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. ### Marriage

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

### Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.

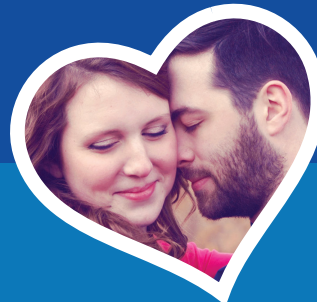
