## FROM FR. STEVE...

Summer is flying by! The month of July is coming to an end. School is starting soon. With that, Families In Faith Registration forms for the 2026-2027 school year were recently emailed. First class is on Sunday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion and Confirmation Registrations were put in the mail. If you did not receive a registration form, forms are available in the parish office. With that, last weekend I announced we will be hosting LakeEdge Middle School Ministry. This program is an engaging, faith-filled experience for youths from 6<sup>th</sup> grade to 8<sup>th</sup> grade led by Fr. Josh Cochrac and Mike Ficznier. The LakeEdge program will kick off on Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup> at 4:30PM. More information forthcoming. Again, I am so pleased we can host this program. Speaking of education, ever thought about contributing to the Angel Scholarship? Contributions to the Angel Scholarship Fund provide tuition assistance for students to attend our Catholic schools; and donors may receive a 100% Ohio income tax credit of up to \$750 (\$1,500 for married couples filing jointly) against their state tax liability. In other words, the state of Ohio allows you to "spend" some of the state income taxes you must pay anyway to provide tuition assistance for students seeking an education in our Catholic schools. The Angel Scholarship Fund is a win-win-win (That's right, 3 wins!) for taxpayer donors, scholarship recipients, and our diocese! The Angel Scholarship Fund directly impacts a family's ability to afford a Catholic education. The fund helps provide high quality Catholic education to students with financial need. It can be directed to any Catholic school in the Diocese of Cleveland. Plus, it allows you to choose what your tax dollar supports. Your participation in the Angel Scholarship Fund strengthens our schools and our future in countless ways. And best of all, your thoughtful generosity makes a big difference. For more information, contact Fred Roberts at the Diocese of Cleveland at (216) 696-6525. Thanks to a donation from a donor who wants to remain anonymous, we were able to fix up the parish office. The last time the office was remodeled was over 30 years ago. The flooring and carpeting are nearly worn out. Plus, the walls were different colors. The parish office should be completed by the beginning of August. At the Masses last weekend, I mentioned Mark Blase needed help with weeding around the parish sign and he got some volunteers. 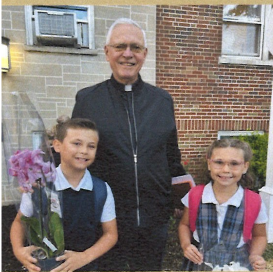

# SACRAMENTS

## SACRAMENTS

### Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. If you are interested please contact the Parish Office. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith should contact the parish office ~ 440-943-2133.

### First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Fr. Steve Breck at 440-943-2133.

### Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. ### Marriage

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

### Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.

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
