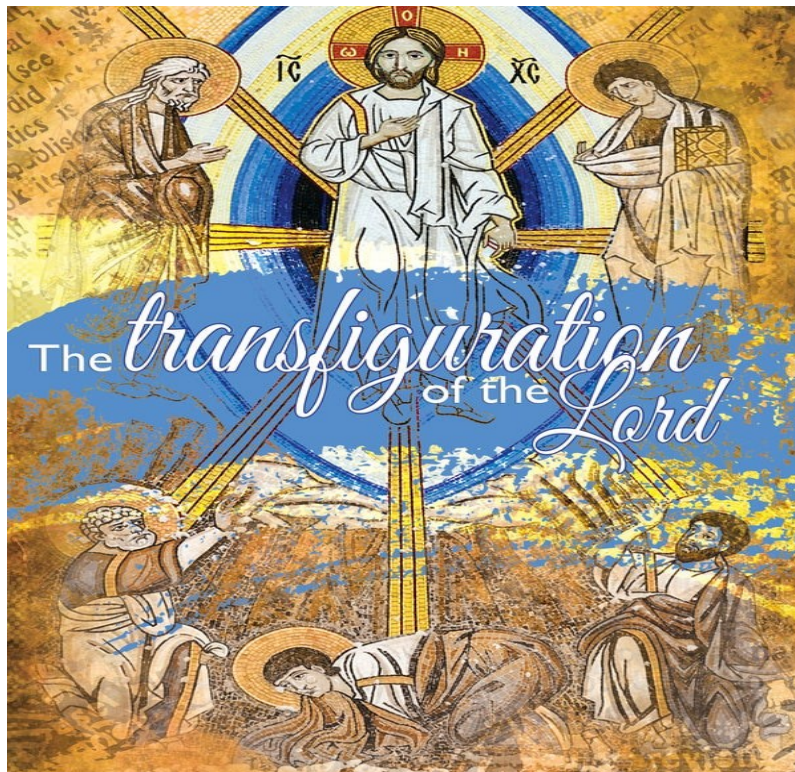

Actually, we exceeded it! Our parish goal was set at \$39,344.00 and through 206 donors, our parish raised 42,351.00 Well done and thank you for your generosity! Your gift will make an immediate impact on people in our Northeast Ohio Community. With that, you may be aware that the Diocesan Wide Campaign, "Called To Flourish" is underway. Some of our neighboring parishes are already participating in this campaign. Every parish is to take part in "Called to Flourish: Our Church for the Future". This diocesan-wide effort will strengthen every parish and ministry across the Diocese of Cleveland. This campaign invites us to renew our commitment to the mission Christ has entrusted to us and that is to grow in faith, serve others with joy, and build a Church that will flourish for generations to come. 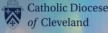

SACRAMENTS

Baptism

The Infant Baptismal Preparation Process assists parents with newborns through age 6 to understand the basic theology of the Sacrament & realize the responsibilities that come with the baptism of their child. If you are interested please contact the Parish Office. Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who are interested in being welcomed into the Roman Catholic faith should contact the parish office ~ 440-943-2133.

First Communion

Children between the ages of 7 & 17 who would like to receive First Holy Communion must participate in preparation classes. For more information, contact Fr. Steve Breck at 440-943-2133.

Confirmation

Youth begin direct preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Fall of their 8th grade year, but they must have been in Catholic Day School or PSR for AT LEAST one year prior. Marriage

The Sacrament of Marriage requires a preparation time of at least six months. Please contact Fr. Breck for information.

Anointing of the Sick

All parishioners who are seriously ill, advanced in years, or facing serious surgery are welcome to receive the Sacrament by contacting Fr. Steve or by attending a communal anointing service, held twice per year. Children are to be anointed if they have the sufficient use of reason (age 7) to be strengthened by this Sacrament.

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
