Thoughts from our Campus Minister

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany - the revelation of God incarnate in the person of Jesus, and the arrival of the three Magi with gifts for the Christ child. I wonder, what was it that drew the Magi to Jesus? Intellectual curiosity? A feeling of wonder? A sense of duty out of respect? 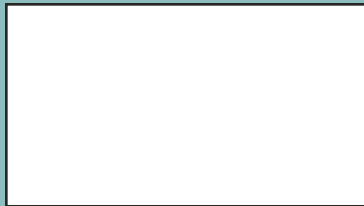

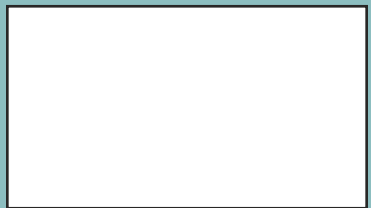
