### Thoughts from Fr. Adam

This past week our Parish celebrated its first anniversary! It has been just over a year since the establishment of St. Faustina Parish on January 4, 2021! We as a Parish have come a long way since the beginning of our merger process nearly three and half years ago. Who would have thought the ways our world would change in such a short time? Back when I arrived in this area in October of 2018, I could have never imagined the ways our world would change — both big and small. Of course, the most drastic changes we see in our world at large are due to the COVID 19 emergency that we find ourselves in. As we look forward into 2022, we have hope that this will be the best year ever. With these hopes, we set our sights on continuing to help make our Parish even stronger.

Relatively speaking the Parish of St. Faustina is very small. Despite our smaller size we still do occupy some of the biggest land area in the Diocese. Between Harrisville, Slippery Rock, Prospect and Portersville and West Sunbury, as well as everything in between, we have a huge area to minister to. Despite our logistical challenges I am constantly impressed with the folks who step up to help improve our Parish.

I would like to ask all our Parishioners to consider how they might serve our community. We are in need of help in literally every area of Parish life; however, I do ask that our Parishioners take a moment in prayer and consider what ways they may help liturgically. *Our Parish is in desperate need of Altar Servers*. If your child is in second grade or older and would like to serve, please reach out to me. That way I can get a better idea of when would be a good time to hold a training session. We are also in need of Lectors at each of our Church Buildings. If you are interested in becoming a Lector, please contact our office and we can put you touch with our scheduler. I also wanted to express our need for musicians. In a particular way we need cantors at St. Peter Church building in Slippery Rock for both the Saturday evening and Sunday morning Masses. If you have in your family or if you know someone with musical ability, please pass this need along to Jim Shaefer, our organist at St. Peter Church in Slippery Rock (you can call the office and we will put you in touch with Mr. Shaefer.)

I also want to take a moment to thank everyone for doing their part in helping with our Liturgies. We are so blessed to have such dedicated and caring Parishioners. As we begin this new Season in the Church year, I pray that you and your families are blessed in the year ahead!


