This Sunday in the Roman Catholic Church is known officially as *Divine Mercy Sunday*. For our Parish of St. Faustina this celebration takes on a very special meaning. This is because the celebration of *Divine Mercy Sunday* is based on the devotion to the Divine Mercy that St. Faustina Kowalska reported as part of her mystical encounters with Christ.

With this celebration of *Divine Mercy Sunday*, according to the writings of St. Faustina we receive from our Blessed Lord the greatest graces and promises related to the devotion of Divine Mercy. St. Faustina wrote that Christ specifically asked that an image be painted that depicted his merciful divinity and that *Divine Mercy Sunday* be established on the first Sunday after *Easter Sunday* to honor the never-ending Mercy of God.

It was on March 23, 1937, that St. Faustina wrote in her "Diary" that she had a vision that *Divine Mercy Sunday* would be celebrated in her local chapel, would be attended by large crowds and that afterward this devotion would grow and spread throughout the entire world, a revelation that absolutely has come true (even the whole way from Poland to Northern Butler County!) This Sunday is also the day after the culmination of the novena of the "Chaplet of Divine Mercy" which our Lord also encouraged us to pray.

As the Church the world over celebrates this special Sunday, we, as a young Parish, are so excited to join in the celebration that has as its true core, our special patron! It is my prayer that all of us can come to know, accept, and ultimately trust in the mercy of Christ. We all can lose our way in the spiritual journey, yet today's celebration reminds us that God's Mercy never ends, and we should never grow despondent at our weaknesses because God's Mercy and Love are always stronger!

Along with the celebration of this Sunday of Divine Mercy, we are also so happy to celebrate some of our young children receiving their very First Holy Communion! Today at St. Peter Church several of our young children received the Blessed Sacrament for the first time and next week another group of our children will receive their First Communion at St. Christopher and St. Louis Churches! (Please see the list of our young children who are receiving their First Communion in this bulletin!)

We, at St. Faustina Parish, have so much to be grateful for! As we enter more and more into these beautiful Spring days, please be assured of all my prayers for a joyful and happy Easter Season ahead!
