One of the best speeches I ever heard was an impromptu speech given by Marine Corps General, John Kelly, on October 19, 2017. While the speech has nothing to do with politics, I felt it threw cold water on a lot of Americans, including myself on how much we take for granted day in and day out. (https://youtu.be/At1hOCEIwE8) He used the event of a congress woman doing something that was irresponsible, to remind all of us how much people we don't understand and that we never met a sacrifice to ensure we are able to enjoy the freedoms we do each and every day.

I've always admired and respected men and women who sacrifice a great deal and in fact risk their lives for the security for their country as I'm sure they all know getting a degree and moving on to the work force would be a much quicker and easier path to ensuring their future. I've also found it intriguing that people in the military refer to their decision to enter military service as a decision to, "respond to the call," which I truly believe it is.

Last week I heard another impromptu speech that was also quite profound. (<u>https://youtu.be/OKtlteNNSHY</u>) When Vladimir Klitchko (who was the former heavyweight boxing champion of the world and was a current mayor in Ukraine) was asked afterwards about his choices when he realized Russia was invading his country; he pointed to the fact that what other choice does he have? When your family, and your country are being threatened by a brutal dictator, that risking your life to protect those who are the closest to you is the only choice you have. It doesn't take much of imagination to realize that the latter speech sent my mind back to reflect upon the former.

Both speeches and the war in Ukraine have caused me to stop, to ponder, and to reflect upon what an oversight it has been for me to take such a significant percentage of our population for granted who have imitated Christ in their decision to "lay down their lives for those the love."


