Pentecost Sunday JUNE 5, 2022



Thoughts from Katie Boosel

Today, as we conclude our Easter Season, the church celebrates the powerful Feast of Pentecost. In a special way, we remember how the Holy Spirit animated those early followers of Jesus, and we consider how the Holy Spirit continues to work through all of us today.

On that first Pentecost, we can only imagine the fear and confusion of those early disciples as they gathered together. They had walked with Jesus throughout his earthly ministry, they encountered Jesus after the resurrection, and witnessed the Ascension. I feel for Jesus' followers, as they sought to make sense of everything that had happened and questioned what to do now. Then the Holy Spirit, the Advocate, the Paraclete, rushes upon them, into them, through them. The Holy Spirit makes no promise that these followers would be safe, insulated from all harm or hatred. But the Holy Spirit allows the disciples to know that they are not alone.

The lessons of that Pentecost still speak to us today. We often talk about how the Holy Spirit continues to breathe life into the church. The Holy Spirit inspired the early disciples to go out and share the Good News! When we cooperate with God's grace, when we listen to the urging of the Holy Spirit, we too are called to leave our comfort zones and go out! To do, to act, to be bold. In Franciscan terms, "Preach the Gospel at all times, use words when necessary."

Our Confirmation Catechists spend a great deal of time discussing the gifts of the Spirit with the students. And they always remind our young people that gifts are freely given and are meant to be used. I thought on this special feast day, as we give thanks for the working on the Holy Spirit in our lives, we can prayerfully reflect on the gifts the Spirit.

"Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.

Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth."

Holy Spirit, we thank you for your abundant gifts, the gifts of Awe and Wonder, Piety, Fortitude, Knowledge, Understanding, Counsel, and Wisdom. We ask your help as we seek to share these gifts with the world, and grow in the fruits of the spirit, to grow in love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control.

And while I have your attention . . .

(I was trying to figure out how to organically include this message into a reflection on the Holy Spirit, alas, I could not make it work right.) As you almost certainly know, we will be having our parish festival this July 22nd and 23rd at the St. Christopher Church grounds in Prospect. As part of the festival, we are looking to once again host a youth talent show!

Anyone in preschool through graduating High School Seniors is most warmly welcome to sign-up to share a talent, special skill, a song, a joke – whatever! We have had young kids sing "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star," keyboardists who are near professionals perform a song, dance routines by competitive dancers as well as siblings just having fun, martial arts and gymnastics routines, and little ones telling a "Knock-Knock joke." These are just a few of the many ways our young people joyfully celebrated the talent show last time – we can't wait to see what they have in store this year! Registration forms are included in this bulletin, available on the website, or in the back of the churches. Please return them to the parish office by July 1st.
