



Thoughts from Katie Boosel

This Wednesday, June 29th, the church will celebrate the Solemnity of Peter and Paul, two great apostles whose contributions to the church are innumerable. These Saints, these Apostles, these Holy men of God, were also human – they made mistakes, they sinned, and, ultimately, they were forgiven. Their lives of faith have so much to teach the faithful today.

Throughout Peter's journey with Jesus, we see the true effort he puts into everything. He has such high moments of faith, from being the one to announce that Jesus is the Messiah, to the absolute low of realizing that multiple times he denied even knowing Jesus. Pope Francis said of Peter, "Though strong and impetuous, Peter often yielded to fear."

Acts of the Apostles first introduces my dear friend St. Paul (Saul) as one who was actively seeking to destroy these "Christians." At its start, Christianity would have been viewed as part of Judaism, and as a Pharisee Paul/ Saul saw it as his mission to seek out those Jews that he viewed to be heretics for their devotion to Jesus.

That God would choose to work miracles through these clearly flawed men; one who journeyed with Jesus, truly knew him, and ultimately denied him, the other who sought to punish or kill any followers of Christ – well, let's just say if I were on the "Apostle's Hiring Committee," those are not the resumes I would look for.

But, as St. Augustine taught us, "There is no Saint without a past or sinner without a future."

During one of his Homilies on the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Pope Francis said: "the Church looks to these two giants of faith and sees two Apostles who set free the power of the Gospel in our world, only because first they themselves had been set free by their encounter with Christ. Jesus did not judge them or humiliate them. Instead, he shared their life with affection and closeness."

Jesus offers that gift of freedom that is forgiveness, and asks us to not only forgive others, but to forgive ourselves of our own shortcomings. Imagine if, after the Resurrection, when Jesus asked Peter to feed his sheep, Peter said no, because he was not worthy. Imagine if after Paul's powerful encounter with the Risen Christ, he thought there was no way he could take the Gospel to the Gentiles, spreading the Gospel throughout much of the known world.

It is ok, even good, to acknowledge feelings of guilt when we have sinned. To feel bad when we fall short. But, God does not wany anyone to stay down in those moments of despair. Much like those first apostles, God calls us to ask for forgiveness, accept being forgiven, and to take God's love out into the world. Sts. Peter and Paul lead the way – let us follow in their footsteps.
