

Thoughts from Fr. Adam

Throughout the priesthood I have been so blessed to not only serve in Parish Ministry but also in the work of a University Chaplain. I have served as the Chaplain at *Washington and Jefferson College* as well as the Chaplain at *Carlow University*. Both Chaplain opportunities occurred as I served as a Parochial Vicar at St. Benedict the Abbot Church in Peter's Township and as the assistance priest to the Rector at St. Paul Cathedral in Oakland, the mother Church of the Diocese of Pittsburgh.

I have a unique role in our Diocese in that I serve both as a Pastor and as a Chaplain. This is not typically the case, but I have been so blessed to work not only with the wonderful people of our Parish congregation but also the inspiring students, faculty, and staff of *Slippery Rock University!* This Sunday marks the last official Mass of the year that is held on Sunday evenings. Please also be reminded that I offer the Sacrament of Confession each Wednesday at 5:30 pm.

In your charity I do ask that you please pray for our students and staff at the University. We are so blessed to have our *Newman Center Building* (also unique in the Diocese) where students can find faith and fellowship. I appreciate all the members of *St. Faustina Parish* continuing to support our long-standing support of *Slippery Rock University!* As the students prepare to take their final exams, I assured them of all your prayers! 


