**30th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

These words of the Lord, recorded in Exodus, can seem harsh, but there is a purpose to the strong language used here. God is making clear how seriously he takes the way we treat our neighbors.

In today's gospel reading we'll hear that the second greatest commandment is to "love your neighbor as yourself." In this first reading, we see that love of neighbor includes (often as the priority) loving the outcasts in society. We see a few different groups of people represented here: foreigners (or immigrants), widows, orphans, and the poor. This is not an exhaustive list, but reminds us that we need to take care of those who are downtrodden.

Love of neighbor does not merely include our friends. In fact, our neighbors include our enemies and those we would not typically associate with. The Lord calls us to love them by helping meet their needs. We should welcome them, treat them with respect, and provide for their needs. This is love of neighbor in action. This passage from Exodus is not the only place in Scripture where we are exhorted to take care of those in need. In fact, the Bible is full of these sorts of commands. Let us, therefore, live out the call to love our neighbor by taking care of the outcasts and downtrodden in our society. (source: stjoesmarion.org)
