

THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The Lord be with you!

"What name do you give your child?" At every Baptism that I have celebrated I have asked that question. Although we might not recognize it, names have power. In the sacrament of Baptism, it is part of the ritual of new birth that sees us freed from slavery to the Devil and adopted as God's sons and daughters.

Question 655. What do we promise in Baptism?

Answer. In Baptism we promise to renounce the devil, with all his works and pomps.

Question 656. What do we mean by the "pomps" of the devil?

Answer. By the pomps of the devil we mean all worldly pride, vanities and vain shows by which people are enticed into sin, and all foolish or sinful display of ourselves or of what we possess.

Question 657. Why is the name of a saint given in Baptism?

Answer. The name of a saint is given in Baptism in order that the person baptized may imitate his virtues and have him for a protector.

Question 658. What is the Saint whose name we bear called?

Answer. The saint whose name we bear is called our patron saint -- to whom we should have great devotion.

Question 659. What names should never be given in baptism?

Answer. These and similar names should never be given in baptism: (1) The names of noted unbelievers, heretics or enemies of religion and virtue; (2) The names of heathen gods, and (3) Nick-names.

My commentary.

For reasons that I do not know, Question 655 forgets to mention what we assent to at Baptism when it brings up renouncing the Devil. Certainly, rejecting the schemes and vanities of Hell is a good idea; assenting to God's grace, however, is even more important! Nevertheless, we can easily forget that without Baptism we do not have a share in God's Kingdom. In reminding us that the world belongs to that fallen angel, Questions 655 and 656 help us to realize that nothing on this earth will ever satisfy our hearts completely.

The rest of today's questions center implicitly on the power of names. Although names are not magical, they can have a profound effect upon us because they shape how we are addressed and how we understand ourselves. Having a name helps us to understand realities about ourselves that we cannot perceive with our senses.

In Baptism our name links us to a particular saint or two. Anyone with a middle name has two patron saints - as well as an instant way for our parents to indicate that we are in trouble. A "patronus" in Ancient Rome was a person of power who would look out for his less powerful clients. In exchange for the patron's support and intercession, the clients would praise and honor their patron. This patron-client relationship is analogously used to describe our relationship with the saints in heaven. A key difference, of course, is that the saints are not interested in being honored for their own sake but always for reflecting the glories of Almighty God. Nevertheless, our patron saints in heaven are more than happy to assist us in our times of need.

Over the last few generations, traditional names have fallen out of favor. Most contemporary names can be traced back to a saint, but some cannot. On that note, people can have some silly ideas about what constitutes a good name. We should not name a child after an enemy of religion or humanity since we are associating a child with a great evil. Again, names are not magical but we do not want to complicate or degrade someone's self worth.

Hopefully, these questions help us to cherish the thought that went into the names that we presently have. The power and responsibility of giving a name mirrors that of giving life. At Baptism a new life of grace takes root deep in the soul. One's given or baptismal names can tell the whole world that grace has conquered death. In Christ,
