

WHEN IS THE RIGHT TIME?

Sunday, January 16th, finds us starting a new season of the church year called "Ordinary Time." When I think about the word "ordinary," what normally comes to mind is "the same old stuff." However, this season is anything but!

Ordinary time marks the season when our scriptures take us through the life of Christ, including the miracles, the parables, the call of the first disciples and the sermon on the mount. It reminds us just as the first disciples came to know Jesus and believe in him, this season is an opportunity for us to deepen our faith. We use the liturgical color green, a symbol for growth and new life, to represent the time of growth and expansion of the church following the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

This Sunday also brings us Luke's account of the wedding feast of Cana. I'm struck especially by the very practical, very human problem facing these newlyweds; running out of something (wine) at the reception. And I'm also struck by Jesus' response to his mother's request to solve the problem, "my hour (my time) has not yet come." In some ways, I have been living my whole life waiting for the right time to do something. Dating for three years, waiting to get married. Waiting for children. Waiting for an empty nest. Waiting for ordination. Waiting for retirement. But then, how would I ever know when the right time comes along?

The new season of ordinary time in the church year reminds me the time is now. Despite the wintry weather outside, now is the time to look inward at my daily prayer practices and find areas for new life and growth to begin. Now is the time for me to look outwardly, honestly see how I am treating my family, co-workers, and others in my life, and to step outside my comfort zone and do something to show I care. The time is now!
