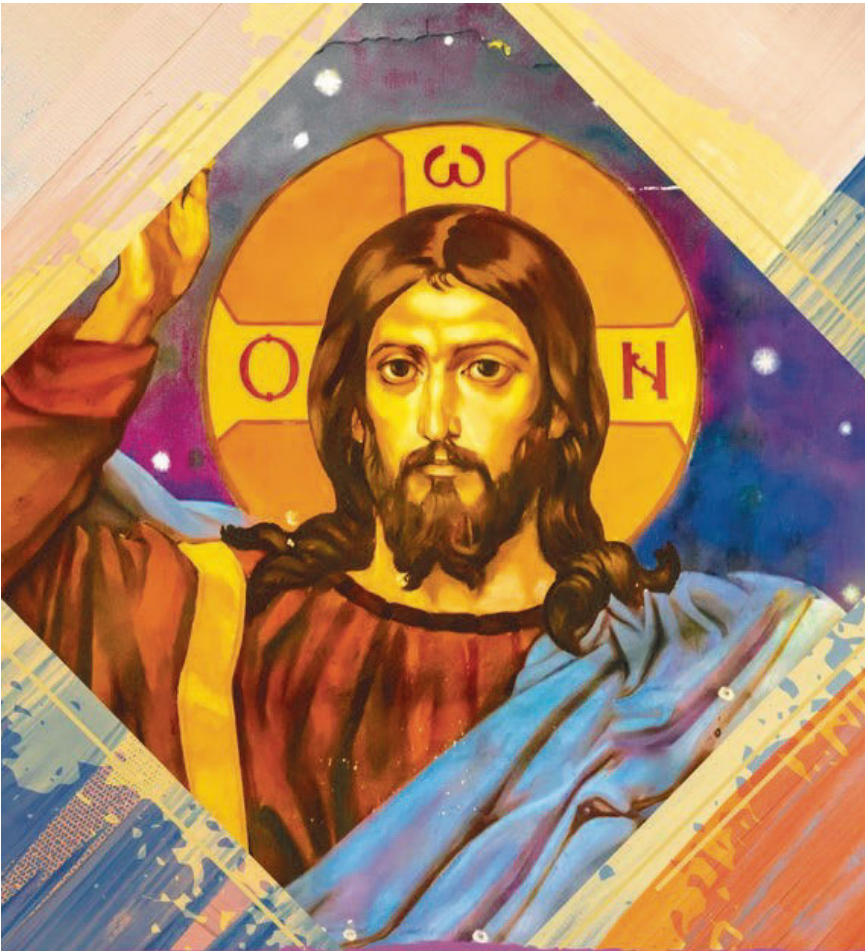

The More You Know...  
Theological Musings



*- with Deacon Dave, Jaquet -*

Our Gospel this Sunday describes how Jesus, in looking at the people of his time searching so urgently for hope and desperately in need of spiritual guidance, were like sheep without a shepherd. He had pity on them and wanted to do something to help them. Those were such dark times under Roman occupation.

Well I for one am glad that was 2,000 years ago, and that everything in our world today is just peachy! Or is it? If Jesus came into our world today in 2023, what would he see? What would he think? Just keeping that question local, there are many Catholics in our diocese who have fallen away, who no longer celebrate the sacraments or do not believe in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. So many in fact that Bishop Persico has begun a new round of pastoral planning which aims to have vibrant parishes who are on a mission to evangelize. And I believe Jesus is moved with pity for us. Sad, but what can I do about it? What can you do about it?



The scriptures are full of divine instructions to GO. In our first reading while Moses was up on the mountain, God sent him back down to GO to the people and tell them to keep the covenant. In the Gospel, Jesus summoned the twelve apostles and told them to GO to the lost sheep of Israel and bring them God's healing love. Through the good news of this Gospel, Jesus is also telling you and I to GO. Is there somebody you know who doesn't come to celebrate the sacraments with us any longer? Is there even one person you know that because of COVID-19, the child abuse scandal, or because of some changes in their lives, doesn't come to mass? GO, invite them back. Even something as

simple as, "we miss you when you are not at mass" can open the door to a life-changing, faith-growing experience for that person. Jesus only asks that we GO and extend the invitation; the rest is up to God.

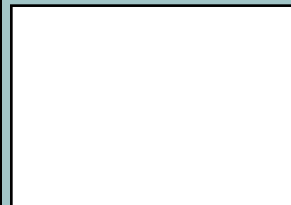
