Dear Friends,

The month of June brings some special events at St. Tom's that I'd like you to mark on your calendar.

The weekend of June 18/19 is the Feast of Corpus Christi and marks the beginning of a national Eucharistic Revival which will be celebrated in the United States for the next several years. We will kick off our celebration with our annual BG Eucharistic Procession. This year, the procession will be on Saturday, June 18 and will travel from St. Tom's to St. Al's immediately following our 5:00pm Mass. I hope many of you will join us for this prayerful devotion and spiritual witness to our BG community.

June 20 begins the Diocesan Priest Convocation. This is normally every two years, but of course we have not had one since before the pandemic. Both Fr. Tom and I will be attending and, since all of the other priests of the diocese are invited as well, there will be no Masses here June 20-24. Though the convocation will conclude on Thursday, yours truly is the celebrant for Holy Mass at the Diocesan Family Day at Cedar Point on Friday the 24th. You're welcome to join me for Mass in the Point Pavilion that day at 10:15am. Admission is required.

We will celebrate our Parish Feast Day the weekend of June 25/26! Since our feast day (June 22) is during the week this year, we will again transfer the feast to the weekend. After both Masses, we will have a Pancake Feast! Who doesn't love breakfast for dinner? And everyone loves breakfast for breakfast! Plan to stick around after Mass to enjoy some food and friendship with our St. Thomas More family.

Finally, please note that the parish office will be closed on Fridays during the months of June and July. The parish office will also be closed this Monday in honor of Memorial Day. We will have Mass and confessions as usual, even when the office is closed. In Jesus through Mary,





## IT'S A WONDERFUL LIFE

Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen announced last week that she believes abortion is necessary for boosting the economy, particularly justifying it as a way for low-income Black women to be able to contribute to the workforce.

Her comments received immediate pushback from South Carolina Senator Tim Scott, who said that he himself was born of a poor Black mother. "Did you say that ending the life of a child is good for the labor force?" he asked her.

"I'll just simply say that as a guy raised by a Black woman in abject poverty, I am thankful to be here as a United States senator," Scott commented, later adding,"My circumstance is like so many others. Millions and millions of kids being raised in poverty by single parent households who happen to be Black. Telling Black teenage moms that there is only one alternative for them is a depressing and challenging message."

Yellen's claim that abortion helps lift women out of poverty is one that Live Action News has previously debunked. The government should be working to help women, children, and families who are impoverished; instead, it's telling these families that they need to kill their children in order to succeed.

I heard a very interesting discussion lately on negativity and how we as people tend to see negative things more readily than we do positive things. The point was being made that throughout history, pessimists were more likely to survive longer than optimists, meaning that "pessimistic genes" were more likely to be passed on to future generations. The example was given of two people observing a rustling bush and the pessimist says. "I don't want to see what is in there. It's probably bad." The other, an optimist, says, "It's probably nothing! I'm going to check it out!" The story ends with the optimist sticking his hand in the bush and dying of a snake bite and the pessimist lives on. While being distrustful, pessimistic, and negative tends to preserve us in the short term, it is not a joyful or peaceful existence. I see this in people who have been hurt by a friend, significant other, or family member and they refuse to trust anyone again in an effort to avoid the pain of another heartbreak. It is easy to be negative and keep others away. It is difficult to remain hopeful and serve our brothers and sisters. In the midst of all the negativity that may be present in our communities, families, or even the news, we must continually cultivate a heart of gratitude, hope, and perseverance. If we continue to let our negativity and pessimism dominate, which are brought on by our fallen nature and brokenness, we will experience nothing but depression, loneliness, and despair. This week, consider praying for a renewed heart of hope and perseverance to guard against the pessimism and negativity that can come so naturally.
