FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

THE SACRAMENTS OF HEALING: RECONCILIATION & ANOINTING OF THE SICK.

What Is Original Sin? :Original sin refers to that condition of disharmony into which all humans are born. This condition is inherited. Universal human experience confirms the Catholic teaching that we are born into a sinful state. The evil we see around us, the anger we have within us toward others and ourselves, the good resolutions we so often break are all evidence of the sin which is part of humanity's condition.

What Is Personal Sin?: Personal or actual sin is any free and deliberate action, word, thought or desire which turns us away from God's law of love. It can be seen as a weakening or killing of our loving relationship with the Father. There are two kinds of personal sin: venial and mortal.

What Is Venial Sin?: Traditionally, venial sin refers to those acts and attitudes which fail to help us grow in our loving relationship with God or weaken the relationship. Venial sin involves less serious matter than mortal sin, or happens when a person does not fully reflect on or consent to what he or she is doing. Sin of *omission*, a failure to do the good thing (an example would be failing to pray on a regular basis). Sin of *commission*, a choice to act in an immoral way (petty pilfering, perhaps taking pens, note pads and other small supplies from work) the person has taken something which does not belong to him/her.

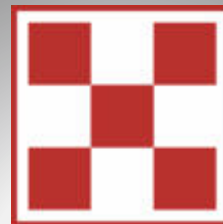

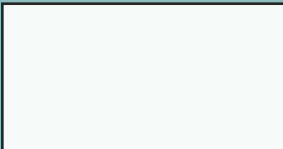
