What's a miracle?

Sometimes we get the wrong idea about Jesus' miracles. We think he performed them to "prove" that he was God. *Not quite.* Jesus was all about bringing the very real, powerful presence of God (his "reign" or "kingdom") into people's lives. He talked about it, but he also did it. Miracles were moments when Jesus brought the Kingdom of God into the world. He healed sickness (Mk 1:21-45); he calmed storms (Lk 8:22-25); he multiplied loaves and fishes for the hungry (Mt 15:32-39); he turned water into wine (Jn 2:1-12); and he raised the dead (Jn 11:1-44). Miracles aren't magic tricks. They also require faith on our part, so that we're open to what God wants to do. God doesn't force us to accept him. That's up to us (Lk 8:48; Mt 13:58).

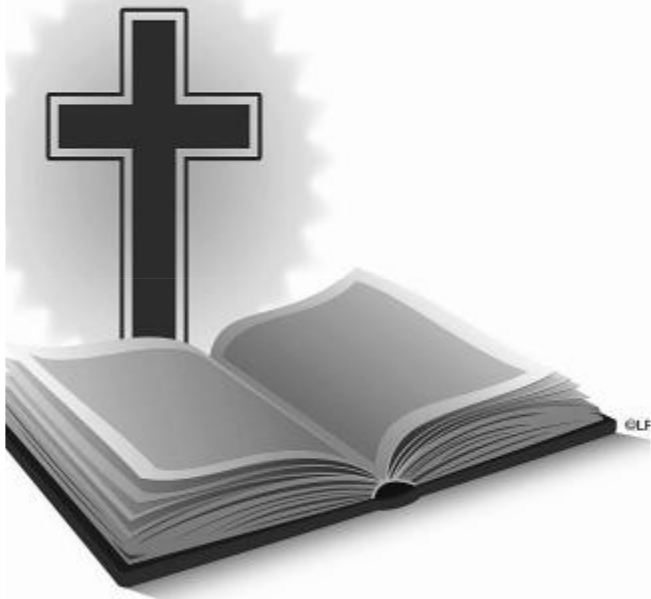

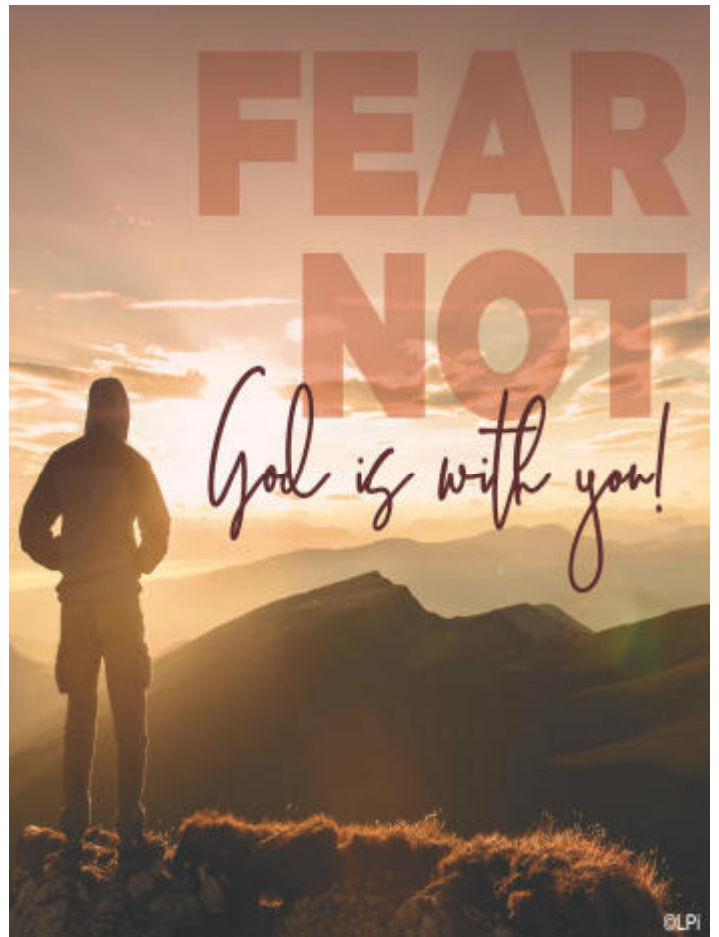

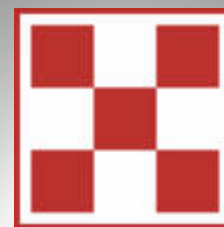
