This Week's Mass Schedule & Events

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

THE EUCHARIST (Part 1)

*The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch."* (CCC #1324)

THE LITURGY OF THE MASS

INTRODUCTORY RITES: the introductory rites help the faithful come together to form a community and prepares them to listen to God's word and to celebrate the Eucharist.

ENTRANCE PROCESSION: while the priest celebrates Mass, he stands "in persona Christi", meaning, in the person of Christ. In the entrance procession we can see the priest acting as Christ did on the way to his death. The side walls of our churches are often lined with the stations of the cross. These tell of Jesus' journey to the cross and of his crucifixion. So as the priest, standing in persona Christi, walks down the aisle lined with the stations of the cross, he looks like Jesus on the way of the cross.

Next week: veneration of the Altar, sign of the cross and greeting of the congregation).

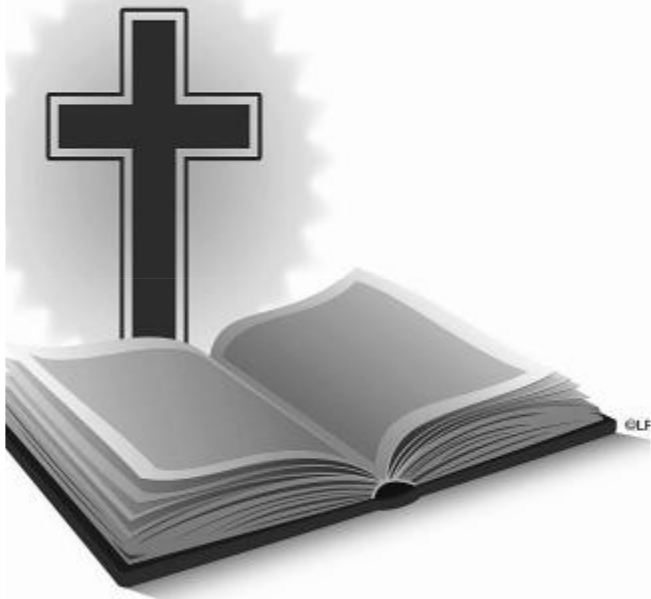

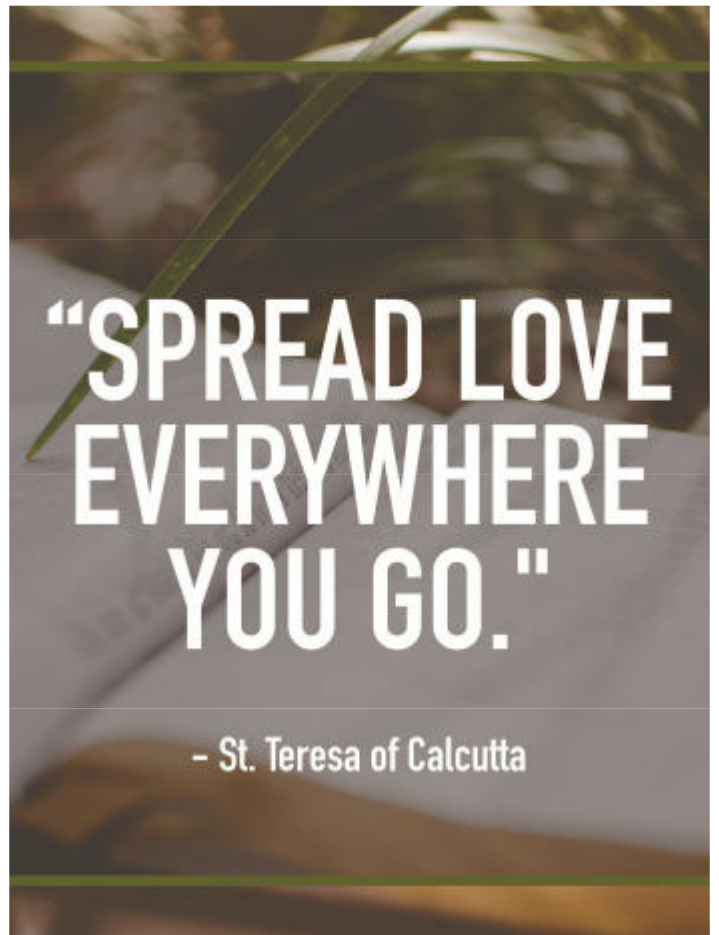
