FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

THE EUCHARIST (Part 2)

VENERATION OF THE ALTAR: When they arrive at the Altar, the priest, altar servers, and whoever else is in the procession give proper reverence. As a sign of veneration, the priest **kisses the Altar**, or more specifically, the relic in the Altar. The relic is usually a bone of a saint or a splinter of wood from Christ's cross. The Altar is the center piece in the central action (the Mass) of the life of the Church.

SIGN OF THE CROSS: *In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19) Amen (1 Chronicles 16:36)* As we make the sign of the cross, it reminds the Lord of his suffering and shows Him the Church, his Bride, is remembering that He died for her sake. The sign of the cross is a summary of the whole Christian faith. By mentioning the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, the sign of the cross refers to the deepest mystery of Christianity, **the Trinity (three persons in one God).**

GREETING OF THE CONGREGATION: *The grace and peace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all (2 Corinthians 13:13). And also with you (Ruth 2:4).* The greeting officially begins the Sacred Liturgy (liturgy means public ceremonial worship). The priest's comments here are the Christian version of hello & good morning. But it is far superior, because the priest wishes graces upon us.

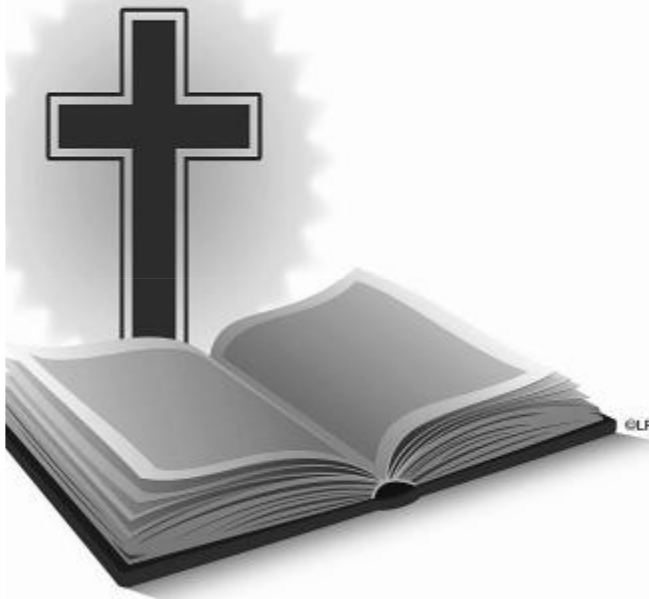
