FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

THE EUCHARIST (Part 5)

ALLELUIA (Revelation 19:1)

Priest/Deacon: The Lord be with you. All: And also with you. Priest/Deacon: A reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark. All: Glory to you, Lord.

While saying "Glory to you, Lord" a small cross is traced on the forehead, on the lips, and over the heart. The first cross we trace asks the Lord to be on our minds or in our thoughts. The second request that he be in everything we say, letting the lips proclaim what the mind contains. The third cross invites him into our hearts.

GOSPEL: The high point in the Scriptures, the Gospels, show us the Eternal Word (John 1:14) of God, Jesus Christ. The Word of God, Sacred Scripture, stands in the place of the Eternal Word of God, Jesus. So when the priest kisses the Book of the Gospels, we see a representative (the priest) of the Church, the bride of the Lamb, kissing her Groom Christ as represented by the Gospel Book.

HOMILY: The word "homily" comes from the Greek word for explanation. Appropriately enough, the homily is the sermon in which the priest or deacon explain the day's Bible readings and applies them to the needs of the particular congregation. The homily is an excellent opportunity for instruction on faith and morals.

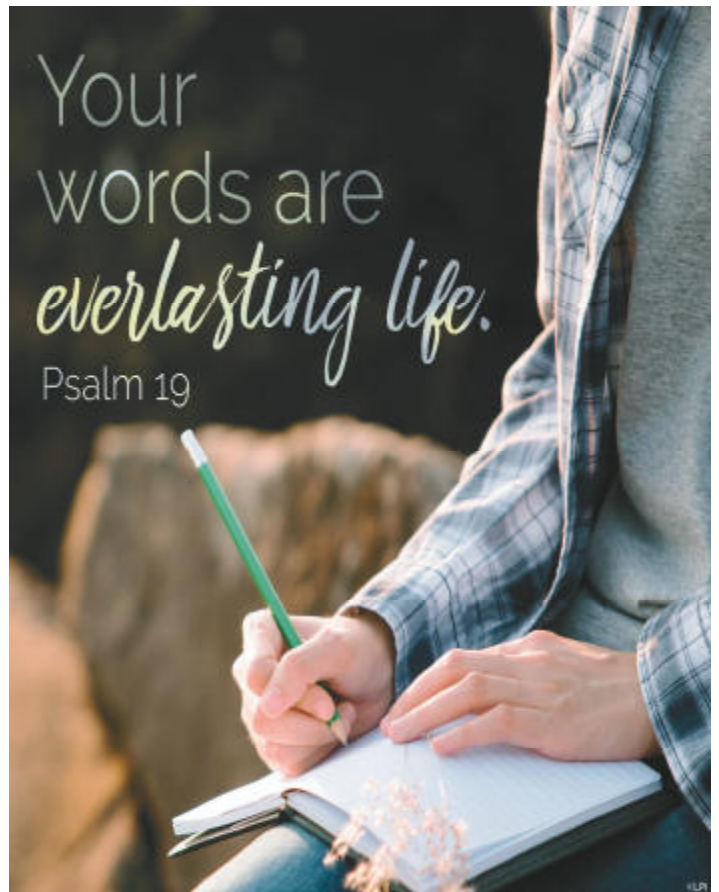

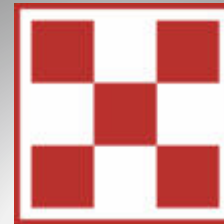
