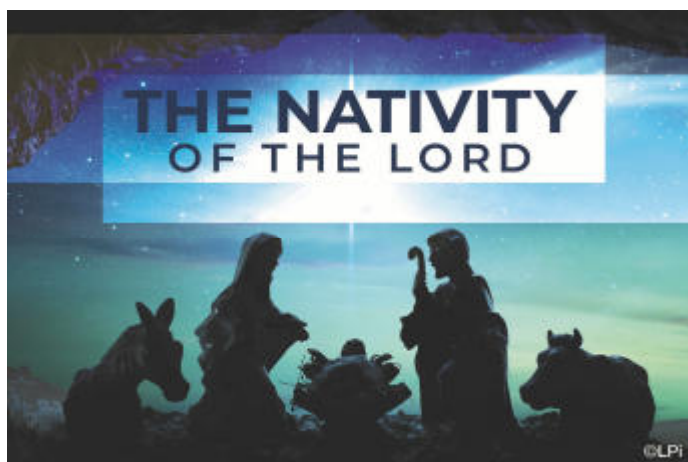

As is being announced elsewhere in today's bulletin, your 2022 Parish Contribution Envelopes have finally arrived. They are set out in ALPHABETICAL ORDER on tables in the corridor that leads to the Parish Halls. PLEASE:

1. Alphabet Letters are posted to indicate where that Surname Letter begins.
2. Look closely at the name on the envelope box top. Be sure it is yours.
3. If many people are in the corridor, continue down the corridor and exit to the parking lot via the Hall entry doors.
4. If you are taking a box home for your neighbor or relative – TELL THEM! Avoid them calling or coming to look for their envelopes when they are on a shelf at your house.
5. If you support the parish online at WeShare, simply use a personal check with name and address on it, or use direct deposit – you will not find a box of envelopes with your name on it.
6. If you do not find your labeled box of envelopes, please check in the front office. You are likely new or inactive.
7. Finally, a tithe, offering, or donation reflects one's sacrifice and gratitude to God for blessings received. What is in the envelope is between you and God! That your envelope is in our collection basket at Mass verifies you are an active, practicing Catholic who worships with this parish community. It's very important for determining parishioner status when asked to be a sponsor.

When I was assigned to you in spring 2018, Bishop Nelson Perez had a task for me (among others) to accomplish: "Pay Off the Mortgage!" With your continued response to this financial obligation, it is my hope that we will satisfy the terms entirely by November 3, 2022. The church, halls, meeting rooms, and offices will be yours and we will 'burn the mortgage'! On that date 20 years ago, Bishop Anthony Pilla with you and Fr. Dunphy dedicated the church. 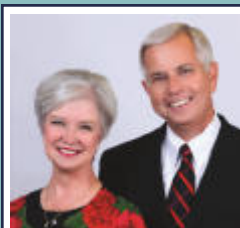
