





At the conclusion of each training, the new ministers will be commissioned.



### SACRAMENTAL LIFE

#### **INFANT BAPTISM**

#### **EUCHARIST**

Communion to the homebound can be arranged by simply calling the Cathedral Office for details and to make arrangements. Parishioners who require low-gluten hosts due to allergies or other medical conditions may contact the Cathedral Sacristy at 513.263.3373 and we will be happy to make the proper arrangements for you to be able to receive Communion at Mass.

#### **INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?**

If you are a child over the age of 7 or an adult, the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adult (RCIA) is a formation program to help you discern and prepare for receiving the Sacraments of Catholic Initiation.
