# Sunday, December 26, 2021 The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

Every year we celebrate this feast to honor the Holy Family. It is, of course, a most unusual family. Joseph and Mary are indeed husband and wife, but Mary's child is not from Joseph nor do Mary and Joseph have what we would consider a normal physical relationship of intimate married love between them. Yet we celebrate them as a family and as a model for us of what a family can be.

We are invited today, then, to think a lot about what makes for a good family. There is probably no such thing as a totally normal family. Each relationship between husband and wife is truly unique and a mystery of God. Each relationship of a child with its parents is also unique and a mystery.

It is important, however, to see that at the very deepest level of relationship the intent to be faithful to what God wants is necessary. Surely this is an aspect of life that is missing in many people and in many families today. One does not have to be Catholic of even Christian to recognize that if there is a God, surely the most profound aspect of our living should be the intent to know, love and serve that God.

If a family is based on this intent of faithfulness to God, the first and deepest level of its existence is properly ordered. This is also true for other types of communities, but the family is such a basic unit that this element of faithfulness to God is most important in the family.

If the basic relationship to God is affirmed and lived in the life of the individual, then the love that can be present in family receives its own proper direction because each member of the family is looking out not for himself or herself, but for what truly reflects the will of God.

We see this in the Gospel today. Jesus could have been more polite and could have let his parents know what He was doing before they set off. His answer is clear: I was trying to do God's will, the will of my Father. This seems to show that even when each person is striving to do God's will, there can be human misunderstanding and even conflicts. In this case there seems to be no conflict. Somehow, in this Gospel story, Mary and Joseph both accept the explanation given by Jesus.

Today there are all kinds of efforts to redefine what a family unit is. We Christians need not get totally involved in that debate. We can only offer this advice: What is God's will? Our life must be about following the Lord Jesus and seeking to do His will at all times. Just as this is the basic element of any family, so also it needs to be the basic element in any decision that we make. Each of us may come up with different answers because that happens at times when we seek the will of the Lord.

Let us ask for wisdom and knowledge for all families today. Let us ask that our own personal lives may be completely guided by seeking God. And let us thank God who loves us to much that He has sent His only Son to be our Savior! "Beloved: See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God."

JESUS, I Trust in You!!!






