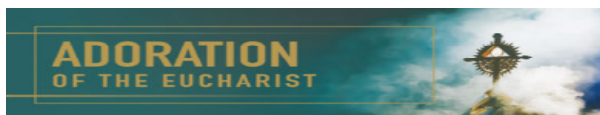

Sunday, January 23, 2022 Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Gospel of Luke today is at the beginning of the public ministry of Christ. He reads the Prophet Isaiah to his fellow townspeople and then tells them that the Scripture is fulfilled there, in their midst. We know that through the ministry of Jesus lots of people followed Him. We also know that lots of people did not follow Him because they did not want to accept His complete teachings.

This is the same today. The challenge of this Sunday is this: will we follow Christ in His Church or will we go our own way? We cannot claim to be following Christ if we do not accept what He teaches. Jesus tells us: come, follow me. Let us walk with Him and in Him find our peace.

To express the importance of what has just transpired, Saint Luke goes on, "Then He (Jesus) began to say." And what did He say? Nothing less than, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." This day, as the people listen, the promise of God, reiterated from generation to generation over the centuries, is so many ways, is now fulfilled. Jesus is the promised Savior! The people are filled with sheer amazement.

How are we to understand this important passage recounted in the Gospel according to Saint Luke? Above all, we are invited to accept Jesus as the Redeemer of all people, and called to pray that we might be filled with wonder at God's love, speaking to us in Jesus of Nazareth, in words that we can understand. God had given to us a faithful, compassionate High Priest and Redeemer, who, because he has suffered, is capable of helping all who have longed for his coming.

Jesus comes every day and every moment in our lives to respond to our most basic and crying needs, to fulfill the deepest aspirations of the heart, to make us fully and forever sons and daughters of God.

We are also called to share the mission of Jesus and to bring the Good News (the Gospel) of freedom from death, forgiveness of sins and full human dignity and love to all other people. This is the goodness of God at work in human hearts!

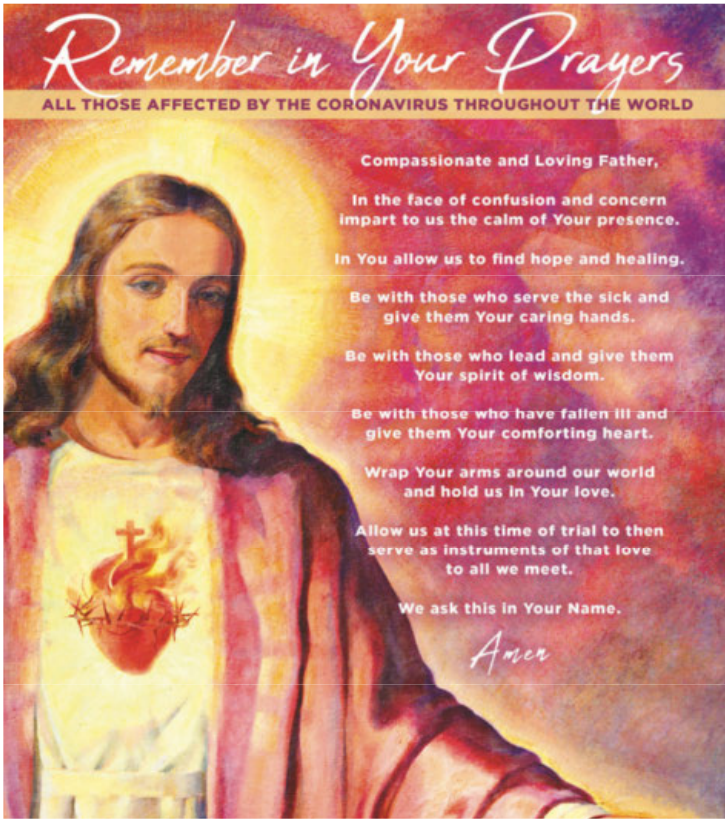

January 20-21 Prayer Vigil for Life

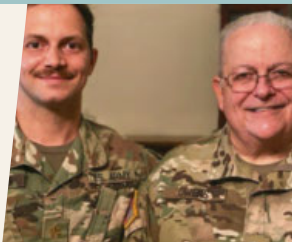
