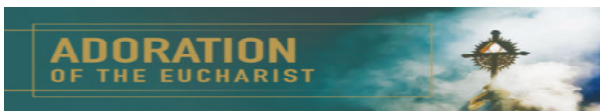

Sunday, February 6, 2022

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isaiah receives some kind of vision of the holiness of God and becomes terrified because he sees his own unworthiness so much more clearly. Perhaps we can identify with Isaiah. That doesn't mean that we have to have some overpowering vision of the Lord but simply some sense of the immensity and incredible love and compassion of God. Even if we just think about those realities and meditate on them a little, we can perhaps understand our own unworthiness even though we know that God loves us.

Peter is always the apostle who is very human, very normal and who denies the Lord in lots of ways, just as we do. Peter is a fisherman and knows how to fish. Peter is a man who believes already in the Lord Jesus, but not completely, not enough to trust that letting down his nets when Jesus asks him to will bring any fish. It is another experience of the power and presence of God. Peter's faith is deepened and his response is so clear and strong: Leave me alone, Lord, for I am a sinful man! But we know that Jesus does not leave him alone. So when Jesus tells him what to do, he is not immediately ready to follow the advice of the Lord. What could the Lord know about fishing? Is not Jesus the son of the carpenter and know the work of a carpenter and not of a fisherman? But finally he says to the Lord: if you tell me to do it, I will do it.

All of us are invited to reflect on our own refusals to accept God and His power and His presence. God is not there to frighten us nor to condemn us but only to love us. Once we begin to believe and to accept forgiveness for our lacks, then we are able to be given over to the work of the Lord. As with Saint Peter, we can doubt many times and we can deny but eventually, when we begin to believe, our lives can be transformed into a reflection of God's mercy, compassion and forgiveness.

Today let us ask the Lord to deepen our faith and give us the courage to proclaim his marvelous deeds. Let us be able to say: Here I am, Lord. Send me!

That last part is the most important part. Peter is always clear that when he knows that the Lord is asking something of Him and when the Lord is right in front of him asking, he will do what is asked.

Jesus has left us the commandment of love. If He were right in front of us, telling us that a particular action needs to be done, we might well obey Him. But because normally Jesus does not appear that way in our lives, we can find ourselves being less than diligent in seeking His will and less than faithful in doing it.

We need to stop for a moment in our own lives and wonder about our experiences with God. How would we describe our own sense of God's presence and power? We can reflect on our own response to God in our lives. This is what Isaiah is sharing with us in this reading. He felt totally incapable of expressing this reality of God. But God himself sends, through an angel, a capacity to sustain this experience. The angel touches Isaiah's lips with an ember and tells him that his sins are purged.


Again we can reflect on our own experiences of forgiveness, both by the Lord and by others. Being forgiven is a humbling experience, but one that allows us, like Isaiah, to volunteer for the Lord's work.

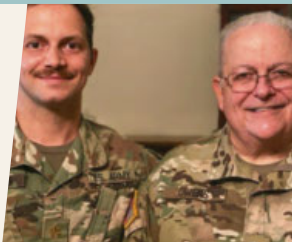
