





Pastor's Note: CALENDARS AND PASSING DAYS

My sister sent me a calendar that includes all the birthdays, deaths, and wedding anniversaries of family members. It is a great way to remember dates just as it helps me know the names of great, great nieces and nephews. It's a big family and there are some whom I have never met.

This wall-hanging calendar also includes a large photo for each month, most of which were taken by my brother-in-law. Some pictures are of scenery. Others are of flowers, fruit, butterflies, and leaves. In those cases, I often marvel at the beauty before me even as I also realize that the object of the photo has long since disappeared. The strawberries were eaten, the butterfly completed its life here in the north, the flowers have wilted and the leaves fell from the trees. The photos captured each of these at a particular time in their life cycle. What we now see is only what used to be.

Time is one of those conditions of living on the earth that is beyond our control. We can't do time travel and go back to the day before yesterday. We also can't jump to sometime in the future. The best we can do is to live each day, accepting it as the gift it is.

As this year unfolds, we may have both good and bad experiences. We may discover strengths and weaknesses. We simply don't know. But days will pile upon days and weeks will crash into weeks. Past flowers may continue to bloom in the calendar pictures, but they will be replaced with new vibrant living flowers this year! Time will move on; we must savor each day for all that it presents to us.

And each day is our opportunity to give back to God from what we have received.

I have always found January to be a good time to review my own charitable giving, especially to my parish. I am asking you to do the same. For some, giving is based on an increase or decrease of income. Others look for a percentage of what they make and try to adjust accordingly. WATCH 'THE SEARCH'


You are invited to watch THE SEARCH through your online device.

The Search is an eight-part program, with each session about a half hour long. You can watch it free on www.formed.org. Our parish, like many in our diocese, has a parish subscription to Formed, so it will not cost you anything. All you do is go to formed.org. The first time, you sign in with your email. When it asks your parish membership, be sure write in St. John XXIII, Perrysburg (there are other St. John XXIII parishes, so make sure you use the one from Perrysburg).

At that point, simply scroll to 'The Search.' Future sign-in's are simpler. There is even an app, so you can by-pass the process.

When you arrive at Formed, you can browse all kinds of other materials and continue to check it out for yourself. There are even movies for you and/or the family.

SIGNING UP FOR VACCINES

The Wood County Health Department tells people over 65 to go to woodcountyhealth.org and then to click on 'COVID-19 VACCINES.' There you can find five places where shots are administered. Each place has its own sign-up procedures.

The first week (beginning Jan 19) is for those over 80, the second week for those over 75, and down by five years each week. For those needing assistance, United Way has a hotline for Wood and Lucas Counties to assist you. Call 2-1-1.

PRAY FOR THOSE WHO DISAGREE WITH YOU

One of the great things about prayer is that when we pray for those who have different opinions, we start to move toward each other. 
