

## Pastor's Note: VACCINES

I have noticed that many people my age are greeting each other with the question: "Have you had your shot yet?" Some are excited to say they have scheduled their appointments; others talk about how little or how much the shot affected them. In short, most people I talk with are eager to get vaccinated, even if it may be hard scheduling it.

I am happy to report that last week I received my second shot of the vaccine. And I feel that it is a blessing that we are able to work together to overcome this pandemic that remains a scourge on our land and the entire world.

Please don't get me wrong. I did not get the vaccine out of worry for my health. Of course, I don't want to get sick. But please do not assume that those who are eager for the vaccine are just living in some type of daunting fear. I received the shot for the good of all. To overcome this virus, it takes many people to have more resistance to it. And, frankly, my concern all along has been that we not harm other people by spreading the virus.

I am willing to concede that there may be legitimate explanations for people choosing not to get the vaccine. But we certainly have to weigh reasons *not* to receive the shot against the good for humanity that can come from getting vaccinated.

I listened to the bells ring 500 times at the National Cathedral on Monday in commemoration of the 500,000 Americans who have died of COVID. I found myself thinking about beloved parishioners included in that number, many since Christmas.

In our world we have been using vaccinations to fight many diseases for years. I can recall receiving the polio vaccine in grade school when it was first developed. We all knew neighbors with polio at that time.

No, I am not saying there will never be adverse effects to any shot. Nor am I saying that someone who doesn't receive one of the available vaccines is a bad person. What I am writing is that our goal is to help the entire world overcome what has become a devastating disease. Receiving the vaccine is a way to help everyone. I can only encourage you to get the shot as soon as you can.

## FUTURE STEPS FOR RCIA

Those in RCIA are in the very holiest part of their journey. Last week they were enrolled at the 11:00 a.m. Mass. Then in the afternoon they were presented to the Bishop who 'elected' them to a season of preparation for the Easter sacraments.

In the next three weeks they will receive what are called the 'Scrutiny' where members of the parish pray over them. We will have each scrutiny at a different Mass so you can pray for them: 11:00 Mass, March 7; 9:00 Mass, March 14; and 5:00 p.m., Mass, March 20. Please keep these 'elect' in your prayers.

## SERVERS AT MASS

As you have seen, we have not had servers at most Masses during the last year. We hope to bring servers back in upcoming months. In May we also will be training new servers, which is usually done in January or February. (Last year we trained new servers, many of whom never got to serve because all parishes went into lockdown in March.) Watch for more information in the next few weeks.

## WELCOME BACK!

Each week we are seeing more people return to Mass. We are very happy that they are back! And at the same time we understand that others may not feel ready to return yet. But know that our church is here. It is safe and clean, warm and welcoming! You'll be overwhelmed to know that through the commitment of so many persons, St. John XXIII Parish is as good as ever.

And although we are still providing safe distance and some other limits, our celebrations will raise your spirit.



## STATIONS OF THE CROSS DURING LENT

We will have three varying versions of Stations of the Cross on Friday evenings. Over the last several years many have found these services to be inspiring. The second of the three Friday night devotions will take place at 7:00 p.m., Friday, March 12. The final session will be on March 26.


It's a meaningful and powerful meditation that takes about 35-40 minutes. Another possibility: you can stop by the church any time the offices are open and pray the stations on your own. We will leave some copies of different formats for you to use in your personal prayer.

## LENTEN OFFICIAL GUIDELINES

The church has the following Lenten requirements for all Catholics. By participating in these minimal sacrifices, we become united with other faithful people throughout the world. I'd like to invite you to read the rest of today's bulletin to see additional ways to enter into the spirit of Lent.

Ash Wednesday (February 17) and Good Friday (April 2) are days of required fast as well as days of abstinence from meat. All Fridays in Lent are days of required abstinence from meat.

By fasting, the church asks that you eat nothing between meals and only one full meal on that day. Fasting is required for all Catholics ages 18-59. Abstinence from meat is for all Catholics age 14 and older. But others are encouraged to fast and abstain as well, if health allows.

## FISH FRIES





- **40 Day For Life**

## ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL

Thank you to all who have already made their contribution or pledge to this year's ACA, the major annual campaign of our Diocese.

At any parish we always want to go beyond ourselves. Any parish that only takes care of itself will fail. Working with other parishes and services beyond ourselves, we can truly be church.


Our target amount this year is \$71,672. That sounds like a lot, and actually it is. But at the same time, we reached over \$66,000 this past year, even with pandemic! Obviously, we won't reach this high goal with a few people throwing in small amounts. It will require both a number of commitments and many to stretch themselves beyond one-time giving. That is, you may want to make a pledge of a certain amount per month or per quarter of this year.
