





Pastor's Note: SINCE LAST MARCH

Today I am thinking about last March and how we became aware of, and responded to, the novel coronavirus, which we have all come to call COVID-19. As I re-read bulletins from last March, I have realized how a full year has passed and we are still in the throes of this pandemic.

Last year, the month of March had five Sundays. On the second Sunday, March 8, we were advised to not share the Sign of Peace or to provide the option of people drinking from the Eucharistic cup. The following week, March 15, people were told the obligation of Mass attendance was lifted, and they were actually encouraged NOT to come to Mass. By the fourth Sunday, March 22, churches – like many other places – were closed. Fortunately for us, we were able to stream Sunday Mass online. The first Sunday Mass that was open to the public came on May 31.

A year has passed. That in itself is hard to comprehend. And we are still conscious of the need to take precautions to protect one another from this virus. Sadly, we have had many parishioners sick with COVID, some of whom were hospitalized. And we lost a number of parishioners to this disease, not to mention parishioners who lost loved ones who lived in other parishes. It's been a devastating year.

Many are also conscious of the other ways this pandemic has taken a toll on people, including loss of income, social isolation, education curtailments, and emotional stress. In short, this has been a year of challenge.

At the same time people have also discovered new ways to reach out to others. Some have become extremely creative. Couples whose weddings were down-sized or postponed, often had the opportunity to focus on the marriage itself. RCIA was extended into June, and candidates used the time to grow in faith.

We all pray that we will come out of this harsh time and find some relief. Until then, we can say we have all discovered our resiliency.




ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL CONTINUES

- ◆ As a healthy parish, we always want to think beyond our own boundaries and our own needs! It's what keeps us healthy and Catholic.





LENTEN RECONCILIATION SERVICE

With great care and every effort being made to provide safe distance, we will have a Lenten Reconciliation Service at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, March 16. It will include a prayer service and readiness for the Sacrament, followed by the availability of five priests in various rooms off the church. This will allow you to maintain distance but also have privacy at the same time. Plan to join us. Other times for private celebration of Reconciliation will also be offered before Easter.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS DURING LENT

We will have three varying versions of Stations of the Cross on Friday evenings. Over the last several years many have found these services to be inspiring.

The second of the three Friday night devotions will take place at 7:00 p.m., Friday, March 12. The final session will be on March 26.



It's a meaningful and powerful meditation that takes about 35-40 minutes.

Another possibility: you can stop by the church any time the offices are open and pray the stations on your own. We will leave some copies of different formats for you to use in your personal prayer.

LENTEN OFFICIAL GUIDELINES

The church has the following Lenten requirements for all Catholics. By participating in these minimal sacrifices, we become united with other faithful people throughout the world. I'd like to invite you to read the rest of today's bulletin to see additional ways to enter into the spirit of Lent.

Ash Wednesday (February 17) and Good Friday (April 2) are days of required fast as well as days of abstinence from meat. All Fridays in Lent are days of required abstinence from meat.

By fasting, the church asks that you eat nothing between meals and only one full meal on that day. Fasting is required for all Catholics ages 18-59. Abstinence from meat is for all Catholics age 14 and older. But others are encouraged to fast and abstain as well, if health allows.
