





## Pastor's Note: ALLELUIA

A recent advertisement on the local public radio station was for a recording of a live presentation of Handel's MESSIAH. Normally, this oratorio is performed and played at Christmas time. But if you actually listen to it, much of it is about the death and resurrection of Jesus. Thus the significance of the Hallelujah chorus that almost everyone loves. We rejoice and we celebrate with all that is within us that Jesus has risen from the dead and 'He shall reign forever and ever.'

But what does 'Alleluia' or 'Hallelujah' mean? First of all, please don't be disturbed that there are differing spellings. Any word brought into English from ancient languages is likely to have been written in more than one way.

Simply put, the word means, "Praise the Lord." But for most of us, there are additional layers of significance. We not only praise our God; we also take joy in doing so. It is heartfelt, uplifting, and often the ultimate expression of our delight in the Lord's goodness.

Throughout Lent we refrain from using the word Alleluia. That is probably both our desire to have more subdued liturgies and our way of 'fasting' from such exuberance until we can exclaim that the Lord is truly risen. Singing the Alleluia once again for the Gospel acclamation helps us recall Jesus' resurrection. This makes our forty-day fast from the word even more worth it.

Liturgical guidelines also recommend that at Mass the Alleluia is to be sung and not simply recited. After all, who would simply recite a national anthem or a college 'fight' song?

Today we re-introduce the Alleluia. Use it to praise the Lord and, in doing so, let your spirit soar.





### LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR...AND HERE'S HOW

Jesus made it very clear that loving your neighbor is essential and, in many ways, both the offshoot of, and the seed for, loving God. We know that already. Many times we are good at expressing love of neighbor through kind acts, helping others when they are down, and in formal ways like contributing to food drives.

There is another way to love your neighbor that requires a response from each of us. That is, we want to love our neighbors by getting vaccinated.

The majority of people I talk with who have been vaccinated express their utter joy in knowing they have done something to protect themselves and their families from the COVID virus. They may not even be aware how they are helping society in general. As more and more people get their shots, the virus has fewer places to go. This is what we have been waiting for throughout this past year.

I was trying to find a comparison. During World War II, when the Nazis were flying bombers over the channel into England, people of the cities, especially London, had to maintain a night-time black-out, usually accomplished by covering the windows so no light would escape. If some people chose not to do this, the pilots would have been able to detect the city below. The response required cooperation from everyone.

So please, as the various vaccines become more available, avail yourself to them. Schedule the appointment. Your neighbors will appreciate it. - Fr. H

## ABOUT OUR PARISH


This is meant for those who are visiting or are not regular members at this parish. This item is also a reminder for those who are part of this parish but have been away from Sunday celebrations because of COVID.

First of all, we want to invite you to be part of who we are. In other words, there are no outsiders. Please join us and feel at home. And we really mean it. If you are not shown respect and courtesy, we need to know so we can learn from our failures.

Secondly, church is people! Everyone who has come here knows this is one of my favorite sayings. This parish does not belong just to the pastor, the bishop, the staff or to those who have been here since day one. As People of God (a term used at the Second Vatican Council, 1962-65) we join together and are on a journey of faith as a Pilgrim People (another term used at Vatican II). We pray together, we learn together, we grow in faith together, and we forgive each other as we sometimes fail.

Finally, in addition to invitation and hospitality, a healthy parish has to find ways to reach out. We know we are part of a bigger community, which includes various towns, the local county, this country, and the entire world. So we always want to look out to the world and see how we can inter-act with others. Our patron, Pope John XXIII, once said, "Open up the windows of the church so we can see out and others can see in." (We can't literally open our windows but they are clear glass for this reason.) The pope was challenging us to see ourselves as part of a larger world. There is much to be concerned about from respect of human life to protection of the life of the planet. And so much more.

This is the kind of parish we strive to be.


