

Pastor's Note: MILE 21

Some years ago I was in Chicago for its annual Marathon. No, I didn't run it, but since I was near the route, I walked over to watch the runners go by.

As it turned out, I was observing from about Mile 21 of 26. I'm told that that is where inexperienced runners often have to 'tough it out' to keep on going. The body is fatigued and the mind plays tricks that say something like, "No need to continue all the way!" But a serious marathoner will go on.

A year ago, when our world entered the challenges of this Pandemic, I wrote that we have to approach our response more like a marathon than a sprint. In other words, we have to keep on going even when we want to call it quits or decide that it is over.

In many ways we are at Mile 21 or so. A great number of our parishioner adults have been vaccinated - something for which we are all truly grateful - and committed parishioners have continued wearing a mask, even when no one really likes doing so. We have done all this because we are running to win!

Thank you for your on-going commitment. And each week we see members of the parish return, often saying they appreciate the fact that we continue to make our church a safe place to worship. We want people back, and we want people to know this is a safe environment.

It's not only with church attendance that we have seen ourselves running a marathon. The same is true for so many of our other programs and activities. We continue to take extra steps because we want to do it right.

This marathon will end, that is for certain. But we don't want to quit before we reach the finish line. We will run by your side!

ACA REPORT


We've surpassed the proverbial 110% and are still climbing!

This program from Catholic Climate Covenant includes prayer, readings, a short video, and opportunities for discussion and action. Link to the program can be found at 23.church.





VACCINE MORAL QUESTIONS

We extend a big thank you to all who have chosen to get vaccinated. We get the shot to protect ourselves, BUT ALSO TO PROTECT THOSE AROUND US, both those we know and those who are strangers.

I still run into people who are hesitant to receive one of the various COVID vaccines because of some moral questions. Our church has made it very clear that morally we should be more inclined to receive the vaccine to help end the pandemic than to avoid the vaccine. (The Pope, the local Bishop and your Pastor have all been vaccinated!) We all know one can find any kind of message online – and I often hear how people fear they are somehow supporting abortion because of the cell-line used in research and development. Those online messages, while perhaps coming from a point of conviction, do not speak for the official position of the church. (I have previously printed the official statement; you can find it at usccb.org. *usccb* stands for United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.)

If you desire to talk about this hesitation, I'd be very happy to hear your thoughts or concerns. – Fr. Herb


