Pastor's Note: THE STRENGTH OF MOTHERS

I was in Nicaragua during the Sandinista-Contra War in 1989. It was a memorable trip in many ways, but one striking incident occurred in Nuevo Leon.

After a meeting with some members of the group, Mothers of the Martyrs and Disappeared, a woman started talking to me. She somehow knew I was a priest and she implored that I tell people back in the United States how Nicaraguans were suffering. She went on to share the story of how her health-care daughter had been 'disappeared' in the hill country while trying to help local peasants.

Politics aside, I was incredibly impressed by the strength of this group of mothers. Every single one of them had lost a husband, son or daughter – sometimes several – but they did not give up in their quest for truth and peace. They were courage personified.

Most mothers who read this, I pray, will not have had the same types of losses as these Central American women. But mothers often can and do exemplify what it takes to seek justice for their children.

Today, rather than examine where that courage comes from, I simply want to say to all the mothers present: we need you and we appreciate your commitment. Don't ever let us forget that every child has dignity and worth. Your willingness to stand up for them is often the only voice that supports them. Thank you.

As we continue to pray for all mothers, especially those who suffer so much for their children, we also express our sincere appreciation to moms everywhere who demonstrate the profound love that makes you who you are.



SACRIFICIAL COMMITMENT






INTERESTED IN RCIA?

Easter was celebrated a few weeks ago and people joined the church through RCIA. This may have inspired others to consider RCIA for themselves. FIRST HOLY COMMUNION CONTINUES

Today is the second of three consecutive Sundays when we will have a First Holy Communion Mass celebrated at 2:00 p.m. We have broken the full group into smaller groups, so that the church will not be over-crowded. The parents and children already know which Mass they are attending. Please pray for the children celebrating this first sacramental encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist.



HOW TO COME BACK TO CHURCH

After talking with people the last few weeks, I have learned that there are several considerations necessary for people returning to in-person church attendance after more than a year. Here is what I am discovering:

- ✓ Let go of expectations. Just accept the experience as it is. For some it is frightening simply because it's been a while. For others it is overwhelmingly affirming of what they have missed. Your experience will be truly your own.
- ✓ Find a place in church that works for you. People are scattered throughout the church. If you come early enough, you can find a place where you feel both freedom and the connection with others.
- ✓ Trust that our space is safe. We cannot guarantee that no one at church is carrying COVID, but we have done everything possible to keep the space safe.
- ✓ Regarding the Mass, you will notice that we still do not have some elements that mean a lot to people (Children's Liturgy of the Word, Collection/Offering, Offertory Procession, or after-Mass hospitality). But you can enjoy what we are doing and don't worry about what is not yet taking place. Those elements will return!
- ✓ Enjoy the music, participate in the prayers, listen to the Lord, celebrate Communion, and truly try to be present!
- ✓ And if you are not yet ready for Sunday Mass, consider coming to a weekday Mass.
