





LOOKING AT ADVENT - THIRD SUNDAY

(This is the third in a series about Advent.)

This is *Gaudete Sunday*, which, in Latin, means “Rejoice” Sunday. The rose (pink) candle in the Advent wreath is lit. And the readings of the Mass tell us to rejoice: “Shout with joy” (Zephaniah, first reading); “Cry out with joy” (Isaiah 12, used as Responsorial); and “Rejoice in the Lord always” (Philippians, second reading). Get the message? We need to rejoice!

What are we rejoicing in? And what is real joy?

When I was young, I used to think the third candle, the candle of rejoicing, simply meant we are getting close to the celebration of the Lord’s birth. Actually, that is a good reason to rejoice whether we are children or adults. But the joy of today is even more profound.

Our hearts are filled with joy because we truly believe God is with us. In the fullness of time God came to earth to be with humanity fully. And in the process, humanity is raised to a new reality of possibility of one with divinity.

That is real joy. Not something frivolous. We are joy-filled because our destiny is renewed and expanded. What more could anyone want? - hw
