

PCU FOOD PANTRY



LOOKING AT ADVENT - FOURTH SUNDAY

(This is the fourth in a series about Advent.)

Over the years I have sort of 'felt sorry' for the final candle in the Advent Wreath. Whereas all the others get to burn on their particular Sunday and each one that follows, this fourth candle only gets a little attention. We will burn it today and the next few days before Christmas. Most of it will be left unburned.

This final Sunday of Advent, in many ways, is so close to Christmas that it is already as if we are at the door of Christmas, knocking to come in.

Scripturally, we have moved to the first chapter of Luke where the birth story is recounted. Mary, having learned she is to give birth, takes the time to visit her cousin Elizabeth. This journey to her aging cousin's house shows both her concern for someone else – perhaps the best way to be ready for the birth of the loving Savior – and her drawing a connection between the two children: John the Baptist who would announce the coming and Jesus who is the Messiah.

As we look at this Sunday, we know that time does not stop for us. One day leads to the next. But we can also relish each moment in anticipation of the great mystery unfolding before us.

CHRISTMAS – WHAT TO EXPECT?

Even though this year is not the same as 2020 when no one was vaccinated, people are nonetheless questioning what to expect at church for Christmas.

First of all, we think we can accommodate everyone who wants to come without it becoming too overcrowded. The busiest Mass is always the one at 4:30, so we will have Roncalli Hall set up for a second Mass at the same time. (Hint: if you want a smaller gathering, consider coming at 10:00 a.m., Christmas morning.)

In the church we will still have some pews blocked off on either side of the altar as well as in the side chapel. This will allow more space between people.

For those who are uncomfortable being in a group setting, we encourage that you wear a mask. In fact, I have noticed that some people are wearing masks regularly just as a courtesy to others.

Although we are not cutting out any of the parts of the Mass, we also intend that the liturgies not be overly long. In other words, we know that shorter periods of time in the same space is better.

Finally, we will not be having the Children's Liturgy of the Word at this time. Hopefully, we can bring that wonderful aspect of liturgy back when it is appropriate. - hw




