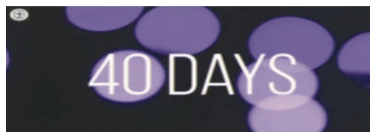
Sunday, January 30, 2022 from 9:15-10:30am in the church. This
