



"April Showers Bring May Flowers" - Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery (Rittman) Floral Policy

- Up to two floral arrangements accompanying the casket or urn at the time of burial will be placed on the completed grave and removed when they become unsightly.
- Artificial flowers are permitted on graves November 1 through April 15.
- Seasonal: Holiday Adornments such as Christmas wreaths (*Wreath Across American*) and grave blankets may be placed on graves from Dec. 1 through Jan 20. To maintain the dignity of the cemetery, permanent plants, statues, balloons, pinwheels, vigil lights, breakable objects, and similar items are not permitted on the graves.
- ◆ The cemetery does not permit adornments that are considered offensive, inconsistent with the dignity of the cemetery or considered hazardous to cemetery personnel (example: items incorporating wires become entangled in mowers or other equipment and cause injury).


