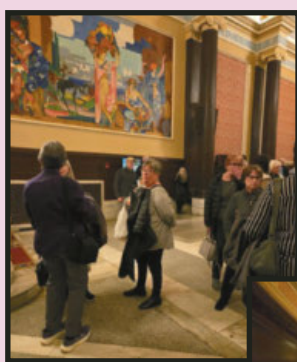
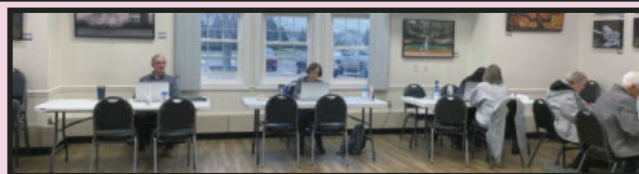
- ♦ *Ohio Western Reserve National Cemetery* was dedicated September 19, 2000

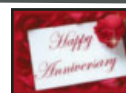

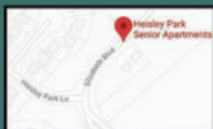
