This week, all the priests in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati who have an active assignment are gathering in Wheeling, West Virginia, for our periodic Priest Convocation. Hence, the Mass schedule this week is pretty limited. We do have other priest emergencies covered, too, but we will be limited in the ‘priestly services’ we can provide this week. Please keep us in prayer this week as we keep you in our prayers this week as well.

On one level, it is always good to be together with the brotherhood. We get to share stories about parish life, the triumphs, and tribulations, we get to spend time in prayer together, share a few meals, etc. It is nice to connect with guys that we spent five plus years in seminary and now hardly connect because of the demands of ministry.

This year, it will be particularly good to connect with our new Archbishop for a few days, too. I have yet to meet him in person, so I hope to share some thoughts with him regarding how we, as a family of parishes, are doing. For one, it is important to remember that even Jesus retreated into the wilderness every now and again, to reconnect with His Father in heaven, and just to take a breath when needed. If He needed to do it, we need to do it, too!

Because it can lead to a greater perspective, too. It can be hard to do the big, long-term strategic thought that is required for the task that is set before us all at this point in history. It is good to see the forest, not just the trees, as it were.

And so, we gather, to pray, to rest, to reflect, to join in fellowship, etc. As always, please keep us in your prayers as we keep you in our prayers.

We are hitting the final stretch run of preparing to welcome our students back into our three school buildings. The summers are quiet and boring around these parts without 1,100 school children running around the three school campus locations, plus the several hundred pre-school children, too! The schools remain healthy and growing, and I look forward to another excellent school year coming up. More information in a few weeks!


GROWING with the GOSPEL



Dear Parishioners from St. Gabriel the Archangel Family of Parishes,

I am writing to tell you about an exciting opportunity I recently received and to ask for your help in making it a reality. **I have been invited to be one of 150 Catholic young adults nationwide who will serve with NET Ministries.** NET (National Evangelization Teams) is based in West St. Paul, in Minnesota, MN; and since 1981, has sent out teams of young adults to travel across the United States to share their faith with youth through retreats and discipleship. NET Ministries will share the Gospel with 80,000 young people in the coming year!

In August, I will travel to Minnesota to participate in a five-week faith-training program to learn how to grow in my faith and effectively share it with others. The first half of training emphasizes personal spiritual formation, and the second teaches practical ministry skills, including relational ministry, which NET uses to reach young people today. From September to May, I will be in full-time active ministry with my NET Team, engaging with youth daily, helping lead retreats, giving talks, leading small groups, and sharing my faith with Catholic youth.

I learned about NET when I was a youth leader at St. Peter Church; my superiors said they were having a NET team come, and I should go and shadow them. After I observed and participated in the retreat, and after I felt closer to my faith, I enjoyed teaching; however, NET offered a spiritual connection not only for the youth but also for myself. Many Catholic youth lose their way in their faith life, and I want to help them get their spark back for the Lord.

I ask you to partner with me to make this year successful by becoming one of my ministry partners. The most important thing you can do as a ministry partner is to pray for my NET Team and me. No matter how well we share our faith with the youth, the Holy Spirit changes their hearts, and we need many prayers asking Him to bless our daily efforts.

Another very important thing I would ask you to do as one of my ministry partners is to help me reach my personal sponsorship goal. As a NET Missionary, I am asked to help cover the cost of my training, healthcare, transportation, equipment, a small stipend, and other missionary expenses which total over \$30,000. **My personal sponsorship goal is to raise \$7,000** for this year of service. **I need about 32 donors** giving gifts ranging from \$100 - \$1,000 (or \$10 - \$100 per month). NET Ministries is a registered 501(c)(3) tax-exempt charitable organization, and all gifts to NET are tax deductible. Below is a QR code and link to my fundraising site.
