

WHAT IS THE "SEVEN SISTERS APOSTOLATE?"

Mt. 26:10) or lavishing of prayer for his deeper conformity to Christ. Our desire is that our prayers may find the heart of every priest and bishop. The initial recipient of a Seven Sisters group is their parish pastor. After the pastor has a committed group, subsequent groups may be formed for others, such as the associate pastor, a retired priest, a priest serving in a non-parish assignment, or a bishop.



Homily

Profession of Faith

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. And I look forward to the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.


