From the Pastor's Desk:

As we continue to move through these first weeks of the Easter Season, the post-Resurrection appearances of Jesus to His disciples and the beginnings of the early Church are the focus of our readings for Mass. Our first reading this Sunday is one that we heard during one of the daily Masses during the octave of Easter. It's a powerful reading in which St. Peter challenges and invites the Jews responsible for Jesus' death to come to Faith, and repent of their evil actions. He gives a brief account of what took place leading up to the death of Jesus and how the leaders treated Jesus as their ancestors treated the prophets before Him. He tells them that while they acted out of ignorance, they can no longer use that as an excuse. The repentance he called them to is what the Church, in and out of the Easter Season, calls the world to. And while it may seem like it's the same-old-message, there's a reason for it: as long as we have air in our lungs, we have need of repentance, need of a savior. He gave His life for us; we are responsible for His death, but we don't just sit here condemned: we have a choice. We can either choose the path that doesn't lead to life, or we can live by faith in the Son of God who loved us and gave His life for us, repent for our sins and follow Christ. Let's continue to respond generously to the great graces of this season and do so with joy! Peace ~ Fr. Paul

A medida que avanzamos en estas primeras semanas de la temporada de Pascua, las apariciones de Jesús a sus discípulos después de la Resurrección y los comienzos de la Iglesia primitiva son el centro de nuestras lecturas para la Misa. Nuestra primera lectura de este domingo es una que escuchamos durante una de las misas diarias durante la octava de Pascua. Es una lectura poderosa en la que San Pedro desafía e invita a los judíos responsables de la muerte de Jesús a venir a la fe y arrepentirse de sus malas acciones. Da un breve relato de lo que sucedió antes de la muerte de Jesús y cómo los líderes trataron a Jesús como sus antepasados trataron a los profetas antes que él. Les dice que aunque actuaron por ignorancia, ya no pueden usar eso como excusa. El arrepentimiento al que los llamó es a lo que la Iglesia, dentro y fuera de la temporada de Pascua, llama al mundo. Y si bien puede parecer que es el mismo mensaje de siempre, hay una razón para ello: mientras tengamos aire en nuestros pulmones, tenemos necesidad de arrepentimiento, necesidad de un salvador. Dio su vida por nosotros; somos responsables de Su muerte, pero no nos sentamos aquí condenados: tenemos una opción. Podemos elegir el camino que no conduce a la vida, o podemos vivir por fe en el Hijo de Dios que nos amó y dio su vida por nosotros, arrepentirnos de nuestros pecados y seguir a Cristo. ¡Sigamos respondiendo generosamente a las grandes gracias de esta temporada y hagámoslo con alegría!
