
Dear friends in Christ:

*An update on the future of our campus: We have retained architects to help us formulate a Master campus plan. This will involve the entire parish and school family, as there will be town hall meetings scheduled to gather your feedback on how we can redesign the campus. In August, per approval of the Bishop and diocesan facilities office, the two homes on campus will be demolished.*

*Please know that this could be a 3- 4 year process. We will move methodical and never spend money that we do not have. Also, we are working in partnership with the city, as they are formulating plans for changes to enhance the city; that discussion will include the two parcels that we own on Brecksville Rd.*

*In her short life (she died from Addison's disease at the age of twenty-six), Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity, a French Carmelite nun, focused her writings on the indwelling of the Trinity: "In heaven each soul is a praise of glory of the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit, for each soul is established in pure love and lives no longer its own life, but the life of God...Saint John of the Cross affirms that "the soul surrendered to love, through the strength of the Holy Spirit, is not far from being raised to the degree of which we have just spoken," even here below! This is what I call a perfect praise of glory!*

### Military Chaplain's Cause for Sainthood Advances

Father Joseph Verbis Lafleur is one of several Knights on path to canonization.

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops voted June 17 to advance the cause of canonization for 1st Lt. Father Joseph Verbis Lafleur, a World War II military chaplain, prisoner of war and a Knight of Columbus whose courageous witness in the Pacific theater of the war brought many souls to Christ. Stationed in the Philippines, Father Lafleur was offered a chance to escape when the Japanese invaded in 1941. When he found out his unit, the 19th Bombardment Group, would not be leaving too, he replied firmly, "Then I shall stay here. My place is with the men." Father Lafleur would spend more than two years as a prisoner of war; he died in 1944 helping his fellow POWs evacuate a torpedoed Japanese prison boat. For his service throughout the war, he was awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, a Purple Heart and Bronze Star. As he wrote in his final message, "If I am not [here], I will be with you anyway and I will have a reserve seat up in Heaven. I am sure Our Lord will let me roll back just one little cloud so I can look down. And from up there I will have a more beautiful view and a more perfect understanding of what is going on." Father Lafleur, a member of Council 2281 in Abbeville, La., is one of many Knights who are either canonized or on the path to sainthood.

### Making Our Author Smile

The readings for this Sunday's mass have all the makings of a Charlie Chaplin film starring his "Little Tramp." The basis of comedy is contrast and conflict, and the mission of spreading God's word is filled with both. This is a heroic mission after all, but God always seems to choose people you'd least expect to be able to accomplish it. A *New York Times* article written in the 70s quoted Chaplin as saying, "*The human race I prefer to think of as the underworld of the gods. When the gods go slumming they visit the earth.*" Not a Christian tenet, but artists like Chaplin did like to take on the role of God through their works. As the creator of HIS world, Chaplin ridiculed mankind's folly, but never lost his affection for the human race. And, his messengers always maintained their dignity. Speaking from his Little Tramp's perspective, Chaplin said: "*No matter how desperate the predicament is, I am always very much in earnest about clutching my cane, straightening my derby hat and fixing my tie, even though I have just landed on my head.*" So keep that iconic image of his "Little Tramp" in mind as we read Sunday's gospel (**Mk 6:7-13**), in which Jesus prepares his men for their mission: *He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick—no food, no sack, no money in their belts. They were, however, to wear sandals but not a second tunic. He said to them, "Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave. Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dust off your feet in testimony against them."* As we tramp through our own lives, we can only hope that by the time the credits roll, our story will have told God's truth and made Him and our fellow cast members smile.


