**Glory to you, O Lord.**

There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." Now there were six stone water jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus told them, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." So they took it. And when the headwaiter tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from — although the servers who had drawn the water knew —, the headwaiter called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him.

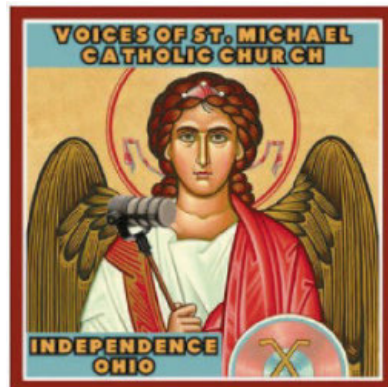

Today we shall ponder Jesus' first miracle, which John calls signs because Jesus doesn't perform them in order to excite wonder but to reveal the love of the Father... The wedding feast at Cana is more than a simple account of Jesus' first miracle. Like a treasure chest, he guards the secret of his Person and the purpose of his coming: the awaited Groom starts off the wedding that is fulfilled in the Paschal Mystery. At this wedding Jesus binds his disciples to himself in a new and final covenant. At Cana Jesus' disciples become his family and at Cana the faith of the Church is born. We are all invited to the wedding feast because the new wine will never run short! (Pope Francis)

### Our Right to Counsel is also a Responsibility

Organizations—even church organizations—are often hobbled by letting perfect be the enemy of the good they wish to achieve. That old proverb has a more modern equivalent in faulty business management: “But we’ve always done it that way.”

As we enter a new year, both philosophies should form the basis of a resolution: to be guided by the Holy Spirit instead of humanity’s time-bound rituals.

Being guided by our history rather than spirit can cause us to ignore the fact that God often answers our prayers via non-conventional means. That’s how Jesus came into the world, after all—being born in the little town of Bethlehem and raised in Nazareth, of which one of Jesus’ first disciples once asked “Can anything good come out of Nazareth?”

But as the prophet Isaiah implies in Sunday’s first reading (**Is 62:1-5**), the low expectations of the world’s powers would soon be raised by this region’s vindication—a word defined as “justification.” Jesus was God’s answer to that prayer of the lowly.

*For Jerusalem’s sake I will not be quiet, until her vindication shines forth like the dawn and her victory like a burning torch. Nations shall behold your vindication, and all the kings your glory; you shall be called by a new name pronounced by the mouth of the LORD. ... You shall be called “My Delight, “ and your land “Espoused.”*

That is why being guided by spirit rather than history is good business, whether in business or in the life of the faithful. As Paul reminds the Corinthians (**1 Cor 12:4-11**), God’s spirit manifests itself in us in many ways, and the most humble among us—like the town of Nazareth—can be a powerful answer to prayer.

*There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.*

Even Jesus, before he embarked on his public life of miracles, might not have seen how a little domestic problem at a wedding feast could turn into His Father’s way of making a powerful statement about problem solving (**Jn 2:1-11**). That lesson came to Jesus, and to us, through his mother’s faith in the annunciation that

began the process of humanity’s salvation—and vindication.

*When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, “They have no wine.” And Jesus said to her, “Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come.” His mother said to the servers, “Do whatever he tells you.”*

Wise advice when it comes to the Holy Spirit—sent to be not only our soul’s vindicator, but our counselor. Be open to it, whatever form it takes.

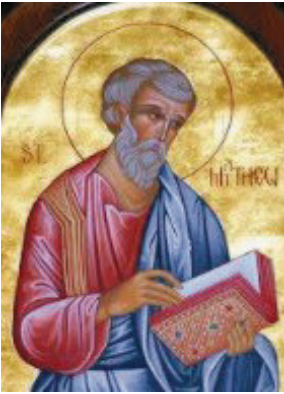

**During Advent 2021, the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland – in sponsorship with the Caritas Baby Hospital Foundation – helped ensure that no child would be turned away at Christmastime in Bethlehem.**

Founded in Bethlehem in 1953 by Father Ernst Schnydrig, Caritas Baby Hospital is the only exclusively pediatric hospital in the West Bank. Its mission provides hope and enhances the well-being of all Palestinian children regardless of their social or religious background or their ability to pay, through specialized, high-quality and safe health care provided in a child-friendly environment. Annually, tens of thousands of Palestinian children are treated – most for free – for a multitude of pediatric diseases, with specialties in pulmonary, neurology, neonatal and congenital disorders. Their motto is, “No child is ever turned away.”

Bethlehem was hit particularly hard by COVID-19, as the pandemic denied the city any tourism, which is the main source of income for the Palestinian Christians living there. The challenging dynamics imposed by COVID-19 added to the already daily stress of chronic patients and their families and increased their need for psychosocial support. This also was worsened by the mounting requests for financial support due to the deteriorating situation. Yet, during the pandemic, CBH was able to serve tens of thousands of sick children.

**The Knights of the Holy Sepulchre, which are active in the Diocese of Cleveland,** hosted a fundraising gala for the hospital on Nov. 20, 2021 at the Shoreby Club. Issa Bankdak, the hospital CEO, was the guest speaker.



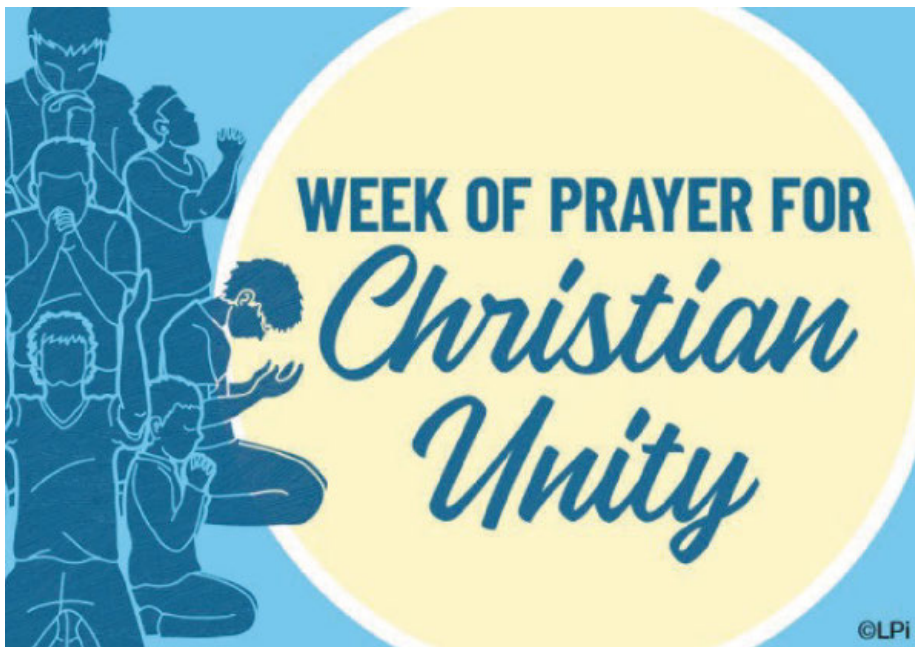
