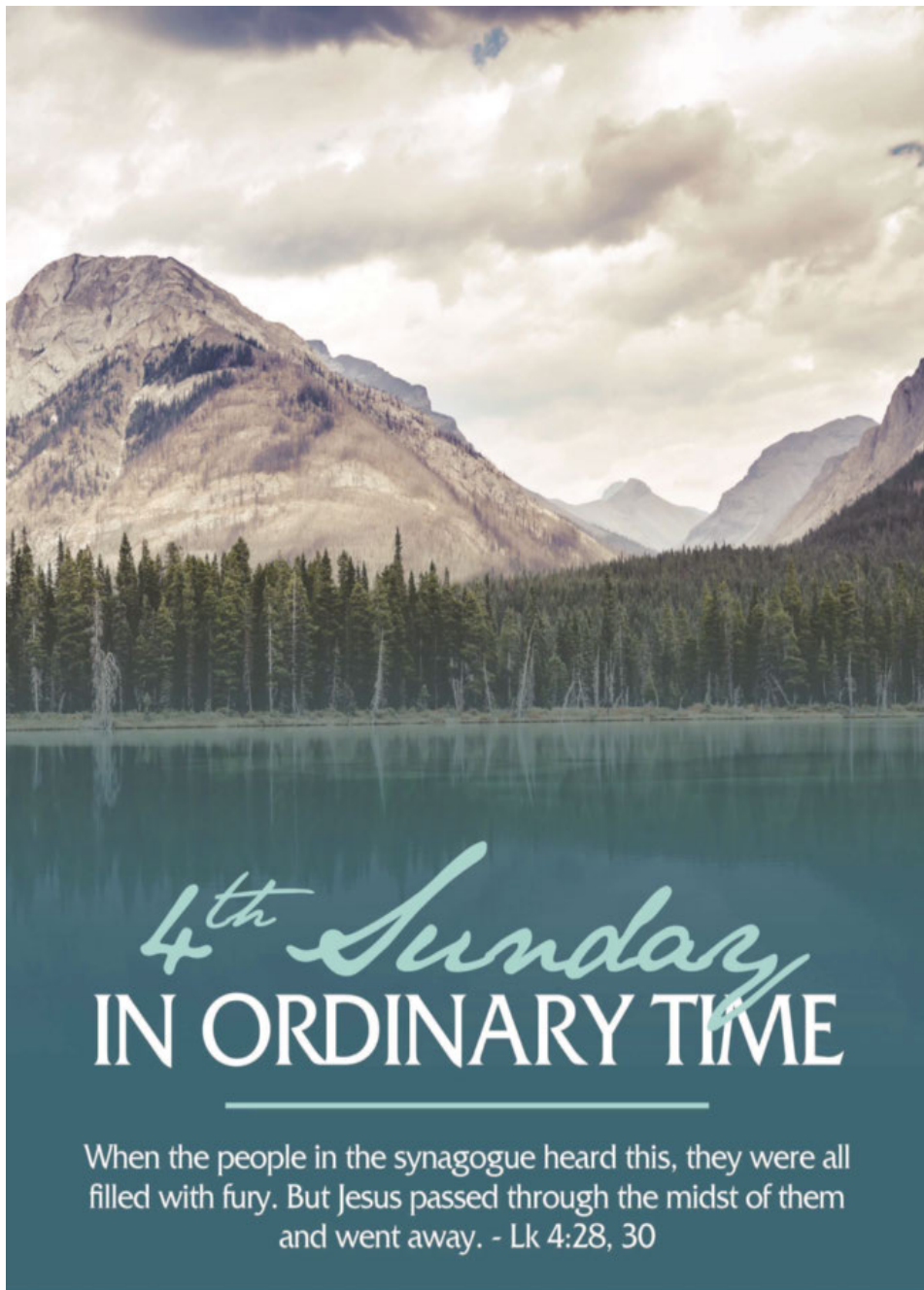

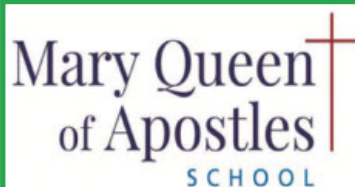

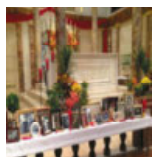


### DIVINE MERCY PRAYER GROUP

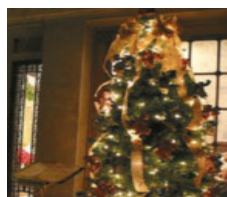

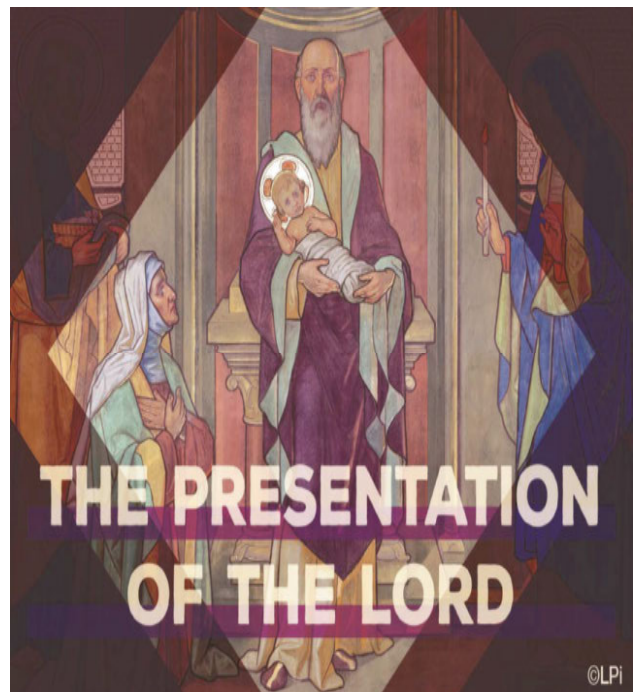

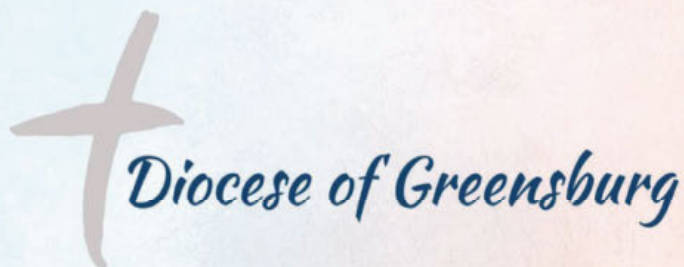
