

Baptisms

Matrimony

Engaged couples must make an appointment with the pastor at least six months in advance of the wedding date. Please contact the parish office.

Anointing of the Sick

Any parishioner who is seriously ill and would like to receive the Anointing of the Sick should contact the parish office.

Holy Eucharist for the Sick & Homebound

Arrange for a visit or receive Holy Communion by contacting the parish office.

Second Reading


In John's final visions, he sees "a new Jerusalem" coming down from heaven. God is fully present with humanity and there is no more suffering and death. How often do you think about the end-times?

Gospel Reading


As Jesus discussed his impending death with the disciples, he presents them with "a new commandment: love one another." In what ways are you challenged by this commandment?



to discover in these the essential elements of Christian discipleship. It describes the basic requirements for receiving the Word of God effectively in our hearts: namely, that we "become wet clay in God's hands", so that God can impress upon us any form he chooses. The author shows that the call to discipleship is above all an invitation to intimate companionship with Jesus. UPCOMING OPPORTUNITIES

Will Vacation Bible School (VBS) return to St. Clare this summer?

Our thanks to two caring adults who inquired about coordinating VBS. At the same time, St. Vivian also inquired about a joint effort with the Blessed Saints Pastoral Region VBS as we are all the same parish family. After discussion and discernment, we agreed that pooling resources would be an opportune way to reintroduce VBS after our two-year hiatus. In two years, veteran volunteers may be opting to new mission fields.
